The Light of Christ is not seasonal. It shines in January and July, in highs and lows, in grief and in growth. No matter what darkness may try to rise around you — the Light still wins.



Let's finish strong. Let's enter 2026 with expectancy, peace, and unshakable faith. I love you all deeply.




