- The entry fee is €10.00 for all individuals. This entitles them to take place in both the individual and doubles events.
- Any team wishing to participate in the Gym Challenges/ the mixed team challenges will be subject to an extra €50.00 fee per team.

All competitors will receive a Diploma of Participation.

Medals (Gold, Silver and Bronze) will be given to the top three finishers in all events.

Trophies will be awarded to the top 3 teams in all 4X challenges.

STEPHANOS MALEKKIDES

Stefanos Malekkides was born in 1959 in the village of Agios Ioannis Pitsilias, Limassol district. He studied Civil Engineering at the Higher Technological Institute of Cyprus (ATI), and then served as a Sergeant in the Special Forces, in the 31st Squadron.

Stefanos was devoted to his loving family and dedicated his professional years in service to the Limassol Town Planning Department. A great lover of sports, he spent a lifetime volunteering in a variety of roles for many sports clubs. Notably, in the field of water sports, he was a dynamic force, and his tireless contribution to the advancement of rowing in Cyprus will live on as his legacy.

Stefanos was a founding member of the Limassol Rowing Centre (LRC) in 2018, as well as of the Cyprus Indoor Rowing Challenge (CIRC). His passion for the sport and his love for LRC gave the team the solid foundation it needed to be a champion club from its first year of inception.

Stefanos passed away in September 2023. He was a great man, husband, father, grandfather, and mentor, and he is dearly missed. His love and passion for rowing will live on in our hearts and our team spirit.
