

6 STEPS TO GET MASSIVE TOMATO HARVEST

The tougher you are on the plant, the more fruit it will yield!



1 LAY THE STEM FLAT



Once the seedling reaches 25 cm, lay the stem flat on the ground.

2 PINCH OFF THE FIRST FLOWER BUD



As soon as the first flower bud appears, pinch it off immediately.

3 REMOVE ALL SIDE SHOOTS



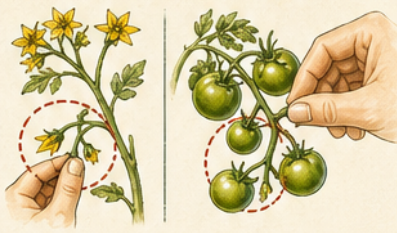
When the plant branches out, cut and remove every single side shoot.

4 REMOVE OLD OR DISEASED LEAVES



Once the fruit has set, clear away all old or diseased leaves, keeping them only causes trouble.

5 THIN OUT EXCESS FLOWERS OR FRUITS



If there are too many flowers or fruits, don't be soft-hearted—thin them out ruthlessly; prioritize quality over quantity.

6 TOP THE PLANT AFTER THE 6TH CLUSTER



Once the sixth cluster has formed, cut off the growing tip at the top to stop it from shooting upward.
