Bringing back flying-fox habitat to Kynnumboon floodplain



Eight year project:

- Funded through the NSW Government's Flying fox Camp Habitat Restoration Program.
- \$181,490- Local Government NSW.
- \$92,775 – Council contribution.
- 3.2ha revegetation area + 1ha existing riparian rainforest.
- 12,000 plants installed (150 species).
- Indigenous and community participation.
- Monitoring to gain local knowledge of rainforest restoration and flying-fox habitat needs.
