The work happening at Namabunda is a collaboration of;

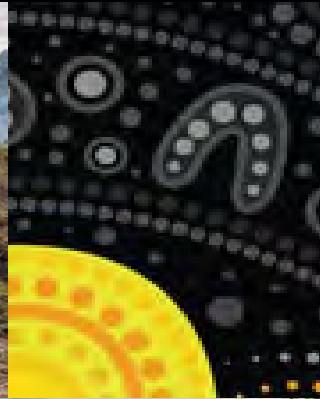
- Traditional Ecological Knowledge
