Premium Sale Rules

Sale rules are made and enforced by the Board/Show Management as part of the Show rules. The purpose of this part of the Show is to help exhibitors bring their projects to a financially successful close.

EXHIBITOR RULES:

- 1. Exhibitors will sign up for the sale when they pick up their packets at show check in.
- 2. In order to qualify for the sale, the exhibitor must have shown and placed an animal in the market show.
- 3. Each Exhibitor will be limited to one (1) qualifying sale lot in the premium auction.
- 4. **Sale Order**: Show Management will determine the order of the Sale. Blue ribbon market animals will be sold starting with those placing highest in the Show followed by those placing progressively lower.
- 5. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to be prepared to enter the Sale ring on time. If the exhibitor is not in the sale line up after the third call, they are considered no show and no sale. Exhibitors should line up at least 20 lots before your designated sale lot.
- 6. Exceptions to the requirement to sell their qualifying place can be granted to exhibitors who have a conflict with the time of the sale. These exceptions require exhibitors to arrange to have another exhibitor at the check-in at sale time. Exceptions will only be entertained from exhibitors who have a conflict with another school sanctioned event or medical issue as defined by substitution rules.
- 7. Each Exhibitor selling in a Grand, Reserve Grand, or Showmanship will be allowed one other Kerr County Exhibitor to enter the auction ring alongside the Exhibitor. All other Exhibitors must enter the auction ring unaccompanied.
- 8. **HIGH SCHOOL SENIORS**: Seniors are allowed to bring a notecard with a synopsis of their future plans. Auctioneer note cards should be 50 words or less.
- 9. Only awards won at the KCSS are approved to be brought into the auction ring. The sale committee may provide additional material at their discretion.
- 10. No Buyer gifts or exhibitors are allowed in the Buyer's area.
- 11. Only registered Buyers are allowed in the Buyer's area.
- 12. On SALE DAY no Exhibitor or family member may solicit a Buyer.
- 13. **Payment to Exhibitors**: Premium checks will be available for Kerr County Exhibitors from their respective supervisors by March 1 or when 95% of auction sales are collected, whichever is later. Add-on recipients will receive their add-on with payment for sale of their qualifying placing.



BUYER RULES:

- All Buyers will be required to purchase a Buyer package, for a minimum fee set by KCSS, to enter the KCSS sale floor. NEW BUYERS will be required to make payment of this fee when they register as a new Buyer. Fees charged to the Buyers, for Buyer packages, will be credited to their account, and may be used at their discretion in the KCSS Sale.
- 2. Registration of Buyers: In order to assure proper and current information is obtained; Buyers and new Buyers must register for a Buyer's number at the Sale. A number will be assigned to each individual purchaser.
- 3. Buyer packages allow entry for TWO people ONLY and are the ONLY way to acquire passes and entry into the Buyers ring. Additional passes will not be sold separately.
- 4. Buyer passes MUST be visible (i.e., wristbands, hand stamps) to be in the KCSS Buyers ring area. Any one not in possession of a pass will be removed from the Buyers ring.
- 5. The Auctioneer's decision or update from the block/podium is final. The auctioneer will decide any arguments or changes, and the bid announced from the block/podium will be final.
- 6. Payment for Lots Purchased: Buyers are encouraged to pay for their invoice at the Sale. Invoices will be mailed to Buyers who are not able to pay at the Sale. Payment is due 30 days from the date of the invoice. Use of credit cards will be provided for Buyer's convenience.
- 7. Starting March 1st, any invoice not paid shall be charged a finance charge of 1.5% monthly until the account is satisfied unless prior arrangements are made in writing and approved by superintendent. All legal options will be reserved to collect on delinquent accounts. Any attorney's fees and costs associated with collection will be passed on to the Buyer.
- 8. Add-Ons: Minimum add-on for all sale lots is \$25.00. All add-ons must be presented on a "Sale Add-On Agreement" (available at the Show Office, or on the web site). Add-ons made during or after the Sale will not be announced during the Sale.
- 9. Should a parent, guardian, grandparent or sibling (including businesses owned by said parent, guardian, grandparent or sibling) of an exhibitor who has a qualifying sale lot at the auction, have an outstanding debt with the association, that Exhibitor's check will not be issued until said balance is paid in full. This rule will apply to money given to any "Buyer's group", used as added money to the Sale, or any other contribution to the auction.
