Fireside Chat




Book Club - Monday, August 14

As mentioned in Fr. Mike's column, the next Fireside chat is planned for Wednesday, August 16 at 7:00 pm, where we will discuss immigration.

"I was a stranger and you welcomed me" ~ Matthew 25:35

The Catholic faith tradition has a long, rich history of hospitality and respect for the stranger or alien. The Church call us to a vision of unity in diversity as part of the parish life by helping immigrants, migrants, refugees and people on the run from injustices.

Attendees are asked to review the suggested

readings and to be mindful of the rules of engagement. Both are outlined below.

Readings

- Bishops call for a better management and continue care for immigrants.
- <u>Two nuns have a message for Catholics angry about their ministry to immigrants: 'We don't have any intention of stopping.'</u>

I also recommend reading a wonderful book called <u>Solito: A Memoir</u> by Javier Zamora.

- Confidentiality What's said here, stays here.
- No preaching We speak from our personal experiences, we are not here to judge, we avoid saying "we should" or "you should".
- No cross talk We listen in silence while others are speaking. We do not comment or ask questions about what others say.
- Respect time Our gathering is 90 minutes. Please respect time so we can all share.
- All are asked to share by coming to this gathering, you agree to participate in some way. Even if it's just your name, we ask you to share something.



Growing in Faith *The Listening Heart: Jesus and the Canaanite Mother*

This story of Jesus and the Canaanite mother shows us a Jesus who listened, and who saw the truth in what this foreign mother showed him, and changed his mind completely, instantly exorcising the demon who was torturing her daughter.

She was right. Here we all are, all of us together here in the household of God, each of us deserving of each other's love and help in need.

This story of Jesus' encounter was copied over and over again until the composition of the gospels, because Christians meditated on it,

shared about it, and used it so frequently for their own spiritual life. They were urged to see every person as God's child, no matter what their background or present religious affiliation or non- religious affiliation.

That readiness to listen, to be open to learn something about our God from those who would ordinarily be regarded as 'foreign', and to be ready to help, is what the story calls on us to incorporate into our hearts. And the story teaches that, like Jesus, our helping someone is not dependent on their joining us. This mother simply returned to her home and her life. This Gospel calls us to be like the Jesus who opened his ears, his heart, listened, and seeing the woman's truth of our being part of a universal family, acted immediately out of love.
