## From Fr. Mike Gabriel

The sacraments of Christian initiation -Baptism, Confirmation, and the Eucharist - lay the foundations of every Christian life That we

are born anew by Baptism, strengthened by the sacrament of Confirmation, and receive in the Eucharist the food of eternal life.

On Saturday, May 14, we joyfully celebrate the First Communion of 38 young women and men. Our communicants, from NCA and St. Gertrude's Religious Education, will all be dressed up in their finery for this joyous event.

First Communion is indeed a cause for celebration and should be memorable as a holy and special day of being welcomed to the table of the Lord. It really can be a challenge to keep focused on the meaning of First Communion, with all the trappings of clothing and parties.

I once heard a speaker say, if a child's First Communion is their best Communion, then we have failed. It may be a child's first communion, but don't forget they will be receiving the sacrament every time they gather at the table of the Lord.

I think back to an analogy of growing up, we had the kid's table and the big people's table during the holidays. When we finally got to move up to the big table, we didn't get dressed up and no fuss was made about it. All of us, I hope, remember that each time we receive the Sacrament of Eucharist we should reflect on its significance.

Parents, I pray that you bring your children often to the table, so they experience the sacrifice and love of God in their reception of the Body and Blood of Christ. Nothing could top that.

This Sunday, we will have our parish May Crowning. All through the month of May, we honor the Virgin Mary as Queen of Heaven and Earth.



All participants will receive a t-shirt, water bottle, and a sports drawstring backpack.


