



RESURRECTION COMPOST GARDEN BASIC GUIDELINES/RULES

- Please put your compostable materials from your bucket in the compost bin labeled DEPOSIT. Do not EVER use the other as this compost is already further along in the process of breaking down.
- Please do not bring your compost bucket into church. You can leave your bucket (with your name on it) in the area by the compost bins and pick it up after Mass.
- Please do not take any completed compost home to your personal gardens. This compost is used to enhance the growing process for our vegetable garden. If there is a time when we have excess finished compost to share, we will let you know.
- Please do not deposit grass clippings and large yard waste into our compost bins. We are accepting dead petals from flowers that are past their blooming cycle (roses, petunias, etc.)
- Please be sure to remove all stickers from store bought fruits and veggies. The stickers are not biodegradable and will definitely stick out in the finished compost product and have to be removed.

Do Not Compost

No meat
No fish
No eggs
No dairy products
No fat, oil, or grease
No fruit pits
No animal feces or cat
litter
No chemicals or cleaners
No personal care products
No yard waste
No compostable bag liners
No compostable plastic
cups or lids
Limit liquids
