September 2, 2025

The Board of Public Works of the City of Tecumseh, Nebraska met in regular session in the Utilities Conference Room, Council Chambers on the 2nd day of September, 2025 at 4:00 p.m., in a publicly convened session, the same being open to the public and having been preceded by advance publicized notice, a copy of the same showing the advance time by which such advance publicized notice was given, a statement of how the availability of an agenda of then known subjects was communicated and the time and specific place of the holding of this meeting. Each member was previously furnished with a copy of said advance publicized notice, the same having been transmitted to each member simultaneously with its publicized notice. The Chair presided and the City Clerk recorded the proceedings.

Chairman Blessing read the statement of availability of current copy of the Open Meetings Act.

Water/Waste Water Report- Jeremy Griepenstroh: ☑ All routine samples passed. 31 Locates. Repaired 4" Main in alley between Clay and RR tracks on 3rd Street. Spencer with HOA adjusted Webster Street valve and tower booster settings. Pumped approximately 28,670,546 gallons, an average of 924,856 gal. per day. Approximately 23,832,970 gallons were processed through the wastewater system. MBA pumped approx. 13,231,719 gallons of wastewater into the treatment plant. TSCI pumped approx. 3,825,872 gallons of wastewater into the treatment plant. Cleaned Clarifier 3 times. Jetted multiple locations.

Utility Foremen's Report – Mike Davison: Generated with OPPD after power outage and damage to transformer, went well. New fuses were purchased. Cooling project progressing well.
