Water/Waste Water Report- Jeremy Griepenstroh- 1 Routine sample failed, all repeats including original location passed. 32 Locates. 1 Read and leave on. 5 Turn offs. 1 Turn on. Replaced heater in Well 6. Fixed a leak on the 6" main on N 13th. Fixed a leak on the 12" main North of the Highway 41 and Highway 50 intersection. Approximately 21,564,729 gallons were processed through the wastewater system. MBA pumped approx. 12,928,507 gallons of wastewater into the treatment plant. TSCI pumped approx. 8,212,230 gallons of wastewater into the treatment plant. Cleaned Clarifier 2 times. Jetted multiple locations. Diverted Effluent back to the river. Ordered and received UV lamps etc for a complete re-lamp. Ordered 10 diffusers that should be in this week. Took quarterly samples at MBA, TSCI, and Influent.

Utility Foremen's Report – Doug Goracke and Mike Davison: Olsson reviewing sewer rats for upcoming year. 2<sup>nd</sup> street water design complete, bid advertisement in next week or two. Generator test went well, scheduled for shipping week of the 13<sup>th</sup>. URD services installed. Boring for JCH project done, wiring next. Still waiting on final award for Grid Grant.
