April 3, 2023

The Board of Public Works of the City of Tecumseh, Nebraska met in regular session in the Utilities Conference Room, Council Chambers on the 3rd day of April, 2023 at 4:00 p.m., in a publicly convened session, the same being open to the public and having been preceded by advance publicized notice, a copy of the same showing the advance time by which such advance publicized notice was given, a statement of how the availability of an agenda of then known subjects was communicated and the time and specific place of the holding of this meeting. Each member was previously furnished with a copy of said advance publicized notice, the same having been transmitted to each member simultaneously with its publicized notice. The Chair presided and the City Clerk recorded the proceedings.

Chairman Blessing read the statement of availability of current copy of the Open Meetings Act.

Water/Waste Water Report- Tracy Milke: All routine water samples were good. 6 disconnects, 4 connects, 8 locates, 10 re-reads and read and leave on. Replaced 2 meters. Pumped approximately 22,473,896 gallons an average of 702,309 gal. daily. New Weber water service line was ran and new pit installed. New water service for new home on 13th street installed. Sargent was here doing some work on the VFD's in the booster. Found a burnt wire and did some adjusting. ☑ Completed quarterly sampling of MBA and Prison wastewater. Had a WW Inspection from NDEE. New DO meter was installed at wastewater plant. Drive for wastewater return pump was replaced. 2 sewer mains were cleaned. 4th and Greely north to Garfield and between Broadway and Jackson in the alley 2nd to 3rd.

Utility Foremen's Report – Doug Goracke - Plant emission test Wed, new catalysts have arrived. Contracts signed for Shawnee sewer project. Water taps done for NAPA. Revised Plant cooling project to be rebid soon. New riser pole for NAPA installed.
