Water/Waste Water Report- Tracy Milke: All routine water samples were good. 7 disconnects, 3 connects, 52 locates,12 re-reads and read and leave on. Replaced 5 meters. Pumped approximately 28,309,367 gallons an average of 913,205 gal. daily. Wells are dropping and I am attaching wells that are close to restriction levels, we might consider odd and even days for watering

yards and gardens. I don't think wells 1 or 2 will get to their restriction level. I will keep you informed. Mba and TSCI Quarterly wastewater samples were completed for the surcharges. MBA, TSCI and Lift Station flow meters calibration was checked by HOA. Cleaned the sewer between Clay and Broadway 4th – 5th.

Utility Foremen's Report – Mike Davison: Works continues to repair tube under Broadway and repair street and sidewalk.

Consider Pay Application #1 from General Excavating, LLC-\$384,293.00- Tabled, waiting for Engineering approval.
