Historically, in times of crisis, Cité-Soleil and other ghettos are the first to be cut off, and the last to receive when activities resume.

The following items would greatly reduce CHF's dependence on suppliers , thus allowing us to provide much needed services more efficiently.

- MRI Machine
- Complete Water Purificagon System for CHF \$25,000 quote from SaniSuisse
- Laboratory Equipment / Microbiology
- Wood cutting, carving, finishing
- First/Aid CPR Training Manequins + Equipment

- 30 Solar Panels + Complete System

Emergency Preparedness and Response:

Important Notes: Hurricane Season is approaching however, the impending dangers are overshadowed by the security and famine crisis. We at CHFF are requesting the following items to mitigate the damages during our preparedness and response efforts.

To support the local economy we would to purchase what can be found in Haiti locally

- 1. Water filters (with under the sink connection and portable for beneficiaries)
- 2. Baby Formula (many new mothers are undernourished and cannot produce enough milk, nor do they have access to clean drinking water to make the bottles)
- 3. Baby diapers (Preemie Toddler)
- 4. Rubber Sole boots for workers for clean up efforts pre and post disasters
- 5. Portable solar lamps
- 6. Thick Gloves, Shovels and Wheelbarrows, waterproof overalls
- 7. Battery operated fans
- 8. Umbrellas and Ponchos (small to XL)
- 9. Waterproof mattress covers (Twin Full)
- 10. Bug repellent sprays/lotions
- 11. industrial pest repellent sprays, foggers and treatments
- 12. Large industrial drying fans
- 13. Water pomps to drain out flooded yards/roads
- 14. Stackable pallets to place important supplies, materials, and equipment higher up
- 15. Protein rich foods
- 16. Multivitamins (children to seniors)
- 17. Waterproof backpacks and bags
- 18. Water and fire proof safes for important CHF files (we are still pen and paper)
- 19. Laminator machines and plastic refills
- 20. Anti fungal foot cream/powder as we anticipate beneficiaries to get fungal infections as they walk through mud
- 21. Stretchers
- 22. Body bags (child-adult)
- 23. First Aid Kits Comprehensive kits with bandages, antiseptics, pain relievers, and necessary medications.
- 24. Emergency Radios** Hand-crank and battery-operated radios to stay informed during power outages.
- 25. Portable Toilets** Essential for maintaining sanitary conditions especially if water service is disrupted.
- 26. Non-perishable Food Supplies** Canned goods, dry mixes, and other staples that don't require refrigeration.
- 27. Mobile Charging Stations** Solar-powered or battery-operated chargers for maintaining communication.
- 28. Temporary Shelter Kits** tarps, and other materials to create emergency shelters.



- 29. Emergency Signal Devices** Whistles, flares, and signal mirrors to aid in locating individuals during rescue operations.
- 30. Hygiene Kits** Including soap, toothbrushes, toothpaste, and feminine hygiene products
- 31. Coloring books, crayons, sharperners for children
- 32. Leggo Blocks for children (There is a Haitian company that makes them from recycled plastic we would like to support and purchase from them if funds are donated)
- 33. Soccer balls, tennis balls, rugby balls, ping pong, basketballs, volleyballs,
- 34. Industrial / Professinoal Pest Control equipment
- 35. Note pads, sticky notes, pens, pencils, erasers, sharpeners, markers, flash cards
- 36. Water proof watches / Motion activated Watches
- 37. Fire Extinguishers
- 38. Ultrasound Film Paper
