ABOUT C.H.F. HOSPITAL

The Center Hospitalier de Fontaine (CHF) is a community health institution operating in the municipality of Cite Soleil since 1991.

The center is located in the district of Fontaine Duvivier, Carrefour Duvivier new road very close to the sub-police station of Carrefour Duvivier.

According to the MSPP, the CHF service area is populated by more than one hundred and eighty thousand people (180,000 people),

People who visit the Hospital come from the communities of Duvivier, Martial, Bassan, Vaudreuil, Blanchard, Damien, Village des Repatries, Canaan, Drouillard, Cite Soleil, Bas Delmas.

The Hospital operates 24 hours a day and has all the essential services: Maternity, Pediatrics, Sonography, X-rays, Dental Clinic, Laboratory, Pharmacy, Operating Room, Community Health (vaccination, family planning, nutrition) Pregnant Women consultation, Mobile clinics where we go to meet the sick and the elderly. We are now working on re-opening our technical school in an effort to stimulate workforce and economic development of the area.

DEMOGRAPHICS OF POPULATION SERVED & CHALLENGES

Located in a marginal area in the heart of the municipality of Cite Soleil, the Center receives the poorest among the poorest, the vast majority of whom are unable to cover even the smallest costs.

Most of the cases we receive at CHF are related to poor sanitary conditions and food conditions.

The vaccination program is full of malnourished children who are enrolled in a nutritional recovery program. Twice a week they receive one egg and and cup of milk.

Despite the efforts of health workers, a very small percentage of pregnant women come to see a gynecologist, which sometimes complicates physiological deliveries with cases of infection.

Local Matrons also present a problem in terms of mother and child safety deliveries. They are trusted however, have little to no medical training and are incapable of handling emergencies. C.H.F. Hospital has started its Matron's training in the hopes of spreading awareness of pre-natal complications and encourage them to refer mothers to the hospital as soon as possible.

The Center Hospitalier de Fontaine does not have stable partner institutions but supporters in sporadic cases such as Food for the Poor, MDM Canada and a few individuals such as HL Construction. The location of the CHF is a major constraint because it is in a risk area, ironically it is there that we find the most destitute requiring help. We are the area's lifeline.

C.H.F. Hospital receives sporadic financial and inkind donations from C.H.F. Foundation whose mission is to provide comprehensive support (financial, material, and human resources) to underfunded schools and hospitals serving marginalized, underserved, underrepresented Haitian communities globally through a strong network of partners.
