





National Pan-Hellenic Council of Washington, DC Future Leaders Award Scholarship Application Guidelines

The National Pan-Hellenic Council of Washington, DC (DCNPHC) is committed to empowering youth in the area with need-based educational resources. We are pleased to announce the 2025 Future Leader Scholarship Application. The scholarship will be awarded to a rising sophomore, junior, or senior who will be enrolled in an accredited institution of higher learning in the District of Columbia in the fall of 2025. The institution may include a District of Columbia college or university.

The DCNPHC will award at least two (2) scholarships in the amount of \$1000 each to two at least (2) undergraduate or graduate students. The application is due by June 2025 and is to be submitted via email to **dcnphcscholarships@gmail.com**. Please include "Future Leader Scholarship Application" in the subject line. The scholarship winners will be notified by June 14th, 2025. Successful applicants will be required to attend the DCNPHC Scholarship and Community Award Reception Saturday, June 21st, 2025, from 3:00 - 5:00 PM at the University of the District of Columbia ballroom.

Scholarship Eligibility:

- Applicants must be an active undergraduate member of a collegiate chapter overseen by one of the 17 member chapters or a graduate member of one of the 17 member chapters of the National Pan-Hellenic Council of Washington, DC, at the time of application (See list of graduate chapters below)
- Applicants must be a rising sophomore, junior, senior (graduating seniors are not eligible) or graduate student (Continued Education, Master, Doctorate)
- Applicants must provide proof of enrollment for the next semester of learning prior to award disbursement
- Applicants must provide an official transcript
- Applicants must provide proof of on and/or off campus organizational participation in community activities

Application Procress

Applicant must submit the following items:

- 1. A completed, typed or computer-generated application form with all requested information
- 2. A copy of resume (optional)
- 3. A 500-word essay, typed and double-spaced, font Times Roman 10 answering "Name three major initiatives that are central to the development of Washington DC and why are these initiatives important."
- 4. A current, official copy of your transcript
- 5. Two (2) letters of recommendation. Recommendation letters can be obtained from a current or former advisor, member of the graduate chapter, professor, pastor, employer, coach, or extracurricular activities director.
