

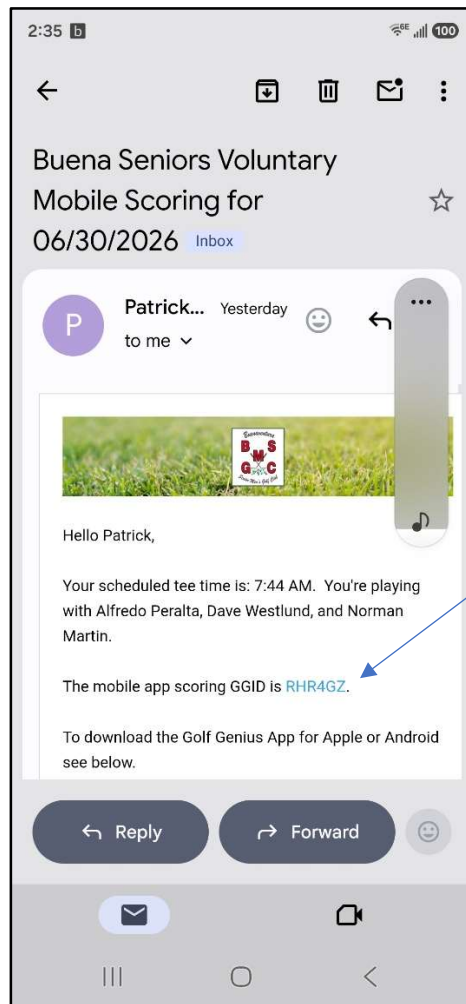

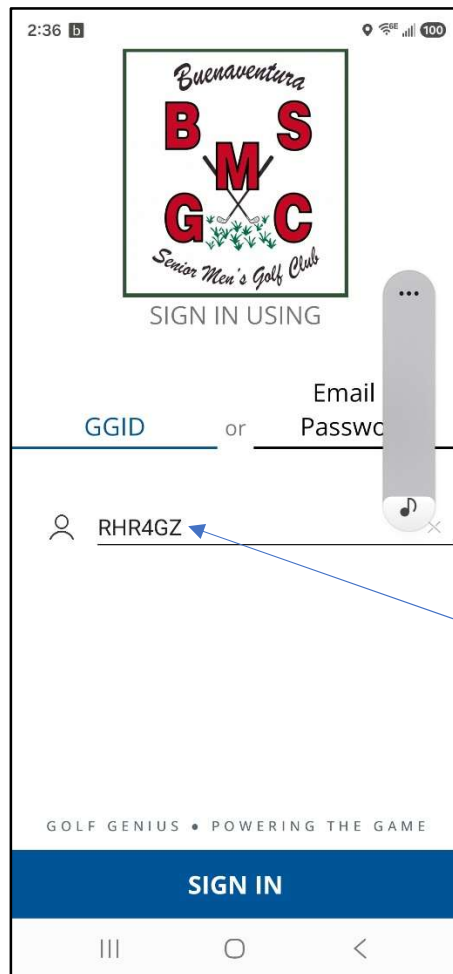


EMAIL MSG

You will receive this email message on the evening before each round. It provides your tee time, foursome, and the GGID for mobile scoring.

Just click on the BLUE 6-character code to launch the GG app.

The email includes links to download the app if you haven't done that yet.



APP SIGN-IN

Usually, when you click on the GGID link it will show this page then jump to the next. If it stops on this page click "sign-in."

You also use this page to access an "event GGID" for results after the round is closed.

NOTE: do not click on "email/password," that is for system managers only (yes, it's confusing!)

When you see this page, check the tournament name, and date at the top, then click on your name as the “scorer” for the round.

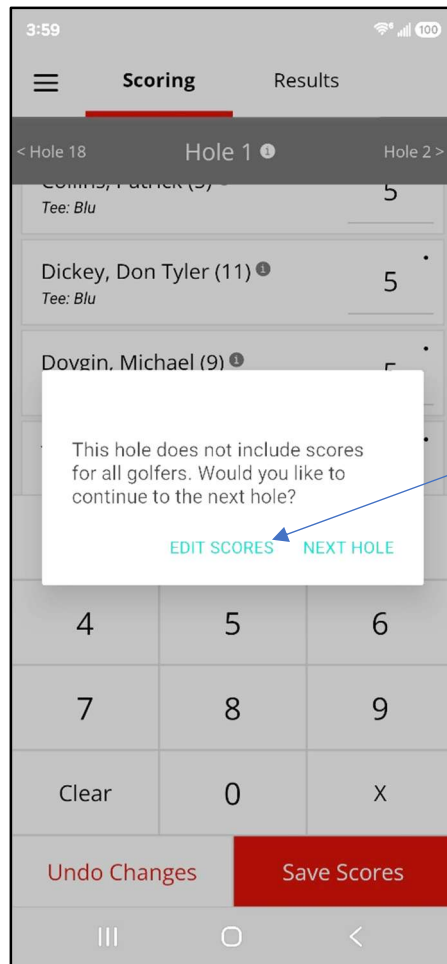
Undo Changes Save Scores

START HOLE 1

After clicking on your name, you should see this screen; verify that you are on "Hole 1." If not, use the small left and right arrows at the top to move between holes.

NOTE: This screen shows each player's handicap and tees.

To enter scores, look for the blinking cursor next to the first name; press the number for the score and it moves to the next player, enter all the scores and press "Save Scores."



ERROR MSG

If you see this msg after pressing “Save Scores,” click “edit scores” and it takes you back to the hole; look for blanks next to player names; click there and enter the score; then Save Scores again.

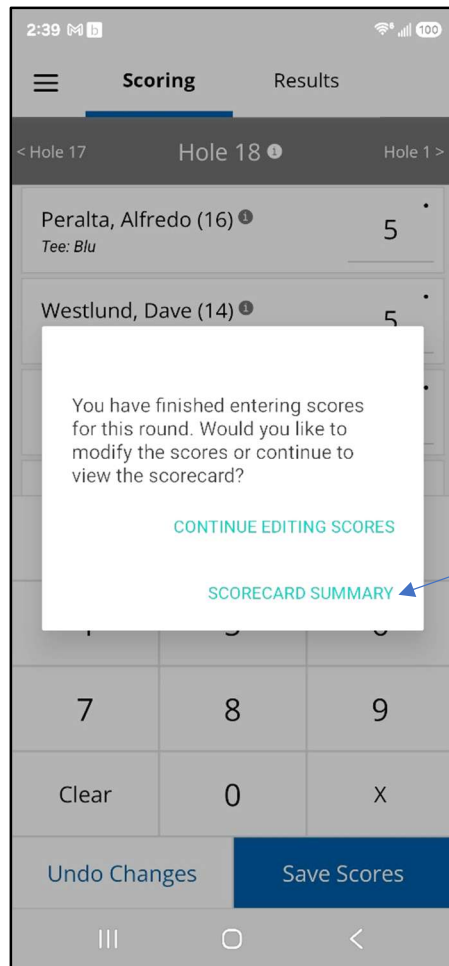

HOLE 18

With each new hole, check the “hole” number at the top center to be sure it’s correct; if not, use the small left and right arrows at the top to move up or down (yes, they are small and hard to see!).

After entering scores for the 18th hole press “Save Scores” again.



SCORECARD SUMMARY

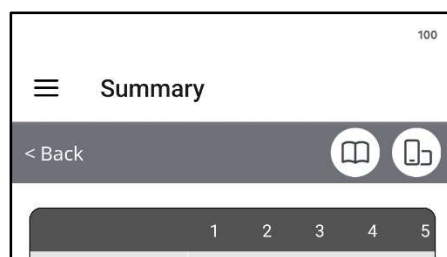
After clicking "Save Scores" for the 18th hole, this message appears, it's not an error, but if you need to go back to a hole choose "continue editing," else, choose "scorecard summary."

REVIEW SCORES

Once you see this page – don't click "view leaderboard" yet, as it's a pain to get back to this page. You can swipe from right to left over the hole scores to see each hole, subtotals for the front and back and the total score.

USE THIS TO COMPARE WITH THE PAPER SCORECARD.

To make corrections, simply click on the score (the keypad will pop up) hit CLEAR then type in the correct number and click Save Scores.

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NO NET SCORE

For those of you that want to see the player NET scores – sorry, that’s not shown here. (you have to go to the expanded “Results” page for that.

But do check each hole, the 9’s and the 18 total against the paper scorecard. The mobile and paper scorers should both sign the card. One of them should keep the paper for at least a week.

KEYBOARD

If you change a score and want to get rid of the keypad, don't press the escape button at the bottom, rather, press the "Back" arrow at the top then press "Save Scores" then "Scorecard Summary." (yes, that's odd, but that's the way it is!)

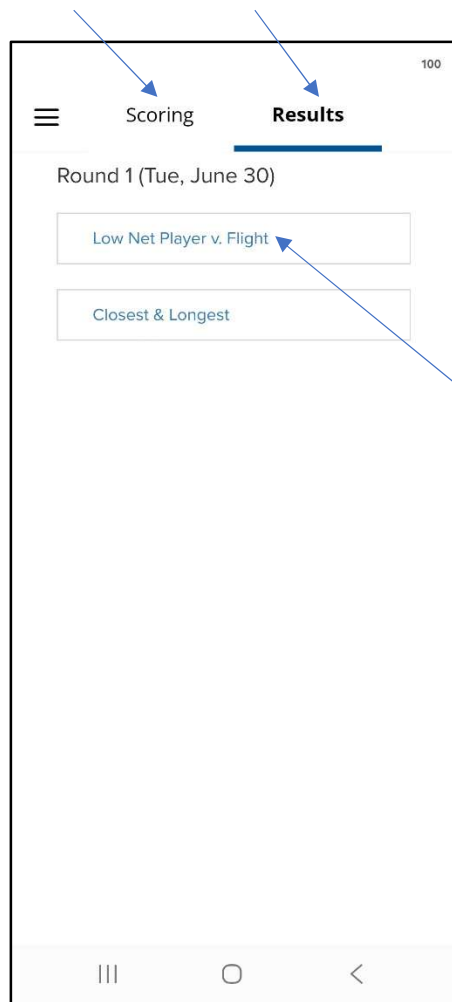
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EDIT SCORES

Again, if you click the back button from the scorecard summary page you will see the individual holes page (usually #18). Use the small left and right arrow buttons at the top to move between holes.



LEADERBOARD

After comparing and correcting any scores on the “scorecard summary” page, click See Leaderboard and this page will open.

Click the tournament name (Low Net, or Low Net/Gross, or Skins, etc.) to see detailed results.

Usually, “closies” will not have been entered yet so don’t bother.

NOTE: you can actually look at results any time during a round, just be sure to go back to “Scoring” to keep entering scores.

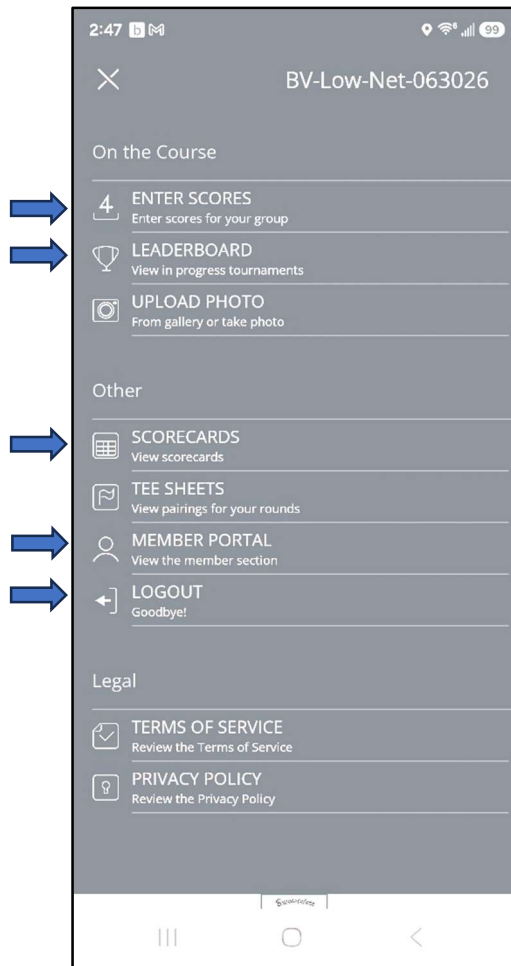
Flight 2

RESULTS

When you open the tournament page you will see results by flight, simply scroll down to see each flight.

You can click a player's name to see their specific scorecard.

Or, click "Expand All" and scroll down to see everyone's scorecard (but the list is usually pretty long).



MAIN MENU

To get to the main menu, click the 3 bars in the upper left corner and you will see this menu.

This is the best place to close the app – use LOGOUT.

You can go back to enter/edit scores and view the scorecards from this menu.

NOTE: the MEMBER PORTAL has tons of stats and other info, but we don't manage that stuff so you're on your own there.
