Toddlers Drop Off Program (16-24 months)

We are a "Reggio" inspired program! In our toddler classroom, children develop their independence through fun learning experiences that promote independence, self-confidence and self-control. Our beloved and caring teachers guide toddlers through playful exploration while helping to establish crucial social-emotional skills.

2s Drop Off Program

A special 2s Program for our youngest learners to develop a love of learning, develop a sense of independence and safety in separation. We'll provide a safe, stimulating and loving classroom setting where we will work on independence – especially self-help and self-care. Each day we present a series of activities that will strengthen each child's foundations skills including social, play and self- foundational skills include self-regulatory skills.

3K Play Based Learning

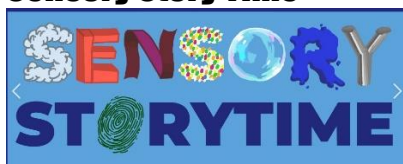
