DIABETIC MEDICATION INSTRUCTIONS

Night Prior to Procedure:

- DO NOT TAKE ANY ORAL DIABETIC MEDICATIONS THE EVENING BEFORE YOUR PROCEDURE.
- You may take your <u>LONG-ACTING</u> insulin (ie. Levemir, Lantus, NPH) the evening before your procedure, usual prescribed does.
- Continue insulin infusion pump if you have one.

Morning of Procedure:

- DO NOT TAKE ANY ORAL DIABETIC MEDICATIONS THE MORNING OF YOUR PROCEDURE.
- Take one-half (1/2) dose of your morning long-acting insulin (ie. Levemir, Lantus, NPH) before leaving for hospital/facility.
- DO NOT TAKE ANY SHORT-ACTING INSULIN (Lispro, Humalog, Aspart/Novolog) or mix (70/30, 75/25, 50/50) or regular insulin.
- Continue your insulin infusion pump if you have one.
