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The sample itinerary described below is approximately like the itinerary your group will be following during your stay with WHITE STAR TOURS. However, the exact times, days, and destinations may vary for your group.

- Day 1 An early morning departure has you heading south towards Florida. It is a full day of travel and overnight lodging has been arranged for you this evening (*pack an overnight bag*); dinner is on your own this evening.
- Day 2 Following breakfast, check out and head to The **Panhandle of Florida**. Arrive in Pensacola in the late afternoon where lodging has been arranged and dinner is included at a local restaurant. (*Please pack a portable suitcase at the hotel does not provide luggage handling.*)
- Day 3 - Breakfast this morning, then visit **Historic Pensacola Village**. The village is a collection of historic sites, museums and restored structures. Key highlights include the **T.T. Wentworth Jr. Florida State Museum**, as well as a variety of buildings including the **1805 Lavalle House**, the **1832 Old Christ Church**, the **1871 Dorr House** and the **1890 Lear-Rocheblave House**. There will be free time in historic downtown Pensacola featuring a charming, waterfront neighborhood and boasting dozens of locally owned restaurants, boutiques, cultural museums and art galleries. In the afternoon, enjoy a **2-hour dolphin sightseeing cruise** along Pensacola Bay and Santa Rosa Sound. Your cruise will also include Fort Pickens, Fort Barrancas, Fort McRee, Pensacola Lighthouse and NAS Pensacola. Once again, dinner will be arranged this evening at a local restaurant
- Day 4 - Following an early breakfast, head west just across the state line into **Mobile, AL**. Upon arrival, go aboard the **USS Alabama Battleship** where you can enter gun turrets, view crew's quarters, sick bay, an engine room and much more. There are 12 decks open for touring along with a 15-minute film, Aircraft Pavilion, memorials and the USS Drum Submarine. From here, continue to **Bellingrath Gardens & Home** where **lunch** has been arranged for the group in the café upon arrival. The creation of Mr. & Mrs. Walter Bellingrath, it first opened to the public in 1932. This 65-acre Garden Estate is always in full bloom with various seasonal flowers and plants. The 15-room home was built in 1935 and all of the Bellingrath's original furnishings are on display. See the "ultra modern" bathrooms of 1935, the kitchen with its original appliances, German silver countertops and sinks and the Butler's Pantry, overflowing with Mrs. Bellingrath's collection of silver, crystal and china. Returning to Pensacola, dinner is on your own this evening.
- Day 5 - After breakfast, continue to the **National Naval Aviation Museum**., located at the Pensacola Naval Air Station - Home of the Blue Angels. Experience hands-on history with more than 4,000 artifacts and over 150 beautifully restored aircraft representing Navy, Marine Corps and Coast Guard aviation. Catch all the drama and power with an amazing **IMAX Film** and refresh with a tasty lunch on your own in the authentic Cubi Bar Café. The afternoon is free to do as you please and the group may possibly want to visit nearby Pensacola Beach. Once again, dinner is included at a local restaurant.
- Day 6 Enjoy breakfast, then check out and travel to your overnight hotel for check-in (*pack an overnight bag*); dinner is on your own this evening.
- Day 7 - Following breakfast this morning, check out and prepare for your departure for home with fond memories of **Florida's Panhandle, Pensacola & Mobile!**
