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Day 1 – Wisconsin Dells, WI – Today, travel takes you to Wisconsin Dells, WI. Check into your local hotel for a two-night stay. Dinner is included this evening at a local restaurant. **(D)**

Day 2 - Lost Canyon Carriage Tour – Market Square Cheese – Upper Dells Boat Tour – Wine Tasting – Free Evening in Downtown Wisconsin Dells – After breakfast this morning, enjoy a carriage tour through Lost Canyon. At Lost Canyon, you ride through a mile of cliff-walled gorges in comfortable yet quaint horse-drawn carriages. At the narrowest passages, the guides must talk to the horses through the tight squeeze. In some of the deeper parts, the sheer rock and sandstone wall have not felt the touch of the sun in more than 50,000 years. Next, stop at Market Square Cheese, family owned and operated since 1969, where you will find the largest variety of top-quality Wisconsin cheese and homemade sausage in the Wisconsin Dells area.

The afternoon features an Upper Dells Boat Tour. This tour travels the Wisconsin River above the dam in Wisconsin Dells. You'll cruise a channel cut by ancient glaciers, passing under pine-crowned cliffs, through the Narrows and past iconic sandstone formations. Your adventure includes two exclusive shore landings: Witches Gulch — a dramatic and spooky walk through a passage carved by wind and water — and Stand Rock — a towering pillar of sandstone that's home to the famous dog leap to the top of the tall rock. Then visit the Fawn Creek Winery for a wine tasting and enjoy the peace and quiet of the woods on the outdoor deck overlooking the vineyards.

Enjoy a free evening in Downtown Wisconsin Dells offering a unique and eclectic mix of shopping options. Stroll through the area and discover a variety of shops, galleries and boutiques plus many dining options. Make sure you stop at the Elm Street Plaza, home to many fan-favorite events including nightly summer entertainment, Farmers' Market, pop-up specialty markets, seasonal celebrations, and plenty of other downtown events. The plaza also has Wisconsin's largest Kugel Ball fountain, along with a giant mural featuring Wisconsin Dells-inspired artwork throughout. And those looking for a laid-back experience will be happy to know it's also a fantastic spot to sit back, relax, and enjoy shaded seating. **(B)**

Day 3 – Lake Geneva, WI - Mailboat Tour Cruise w/lunch – Geneva Lake Museum – Free Afternoon – This morning, travel to Lake Geneva, WI where you will experience a one-of-a-kind cruise, The US Mailboat Tour. There are only handful of places left in the country where mail is still delivered by boat and none with a more exciting and scenic tour than this! Join the daring mail jumpers on this exciting cruise as they leap from the boat to deliver mail to 75 lakeside residents – without waiting for it to stop! Witness the thrilling feat up close as our captain and crew share stories of Lake Geneva's historic lakeshore estates. Lunch will also be included today following your tour.

Then step back in time at the Geneva Lake Museum. Begin with Potawatami Indian artifacts and Frontier cabin. Then walk along "Main Street" where you can not only peek into historic stores, homes, a school room and other places, but you can go into them for a close up look at furniture, clothing, tools, machines, merchandise, photos and other artifacts of daily living. Take this stroll and you will get a real feel for life and lifestyles in the late 19th and early 20th century in the Geneva Lake area.

The afternoon also features free time for shopping and to explore Lake Geneva on your own. Check into your local hotel for a two-night stay. Dinner is on your own this evening. **(B,L)**

Day 4 – Matinee Show at Fireside Theatre – Free Afternoon in Lake Geneva - Dancing Horses Dinner Show – Today, features a matinee show at the Fireside Theatre in Fort Atkins, WI. Here you enjoy an early lunch in their restaurant followed by a show in the 700-seat theatre.
