What is an SGO?

SGO stands for Scholarship Granting Organization.

Ohio established SGOs in 2021 to provide families with more opportunities to afford private K–12 education. SGOs are nonprofit 501(c)(3) organizations certified each year by the Ohio Attorney General (Ohio Revised Code Section 5747.73). There are currently 76 certified SGOs across the state of Ohio.

How are scholarships funded?

Ohio taxpayers can support scholarships for students by contributing to an SGO and, in return, receive a 100% nonrefundable tax credit on their Ohio income tax liability (*up to \$750 for individuals and \$1,500 for couples filing jointly*).



Who receives scholarships?

Scholarships are awarded primarily to K–12 students, with priority given to families with low incomes.
