EXECUTIVE BOARD MEETING

July 24, 2019

1. Meeting was called to order at 1900 hours. Roll was not called. The Adjutant was absent and the minutes were taken by Janet English of the Auxiliary.
2. Ed English offered the opening and closing prayers.
3. The Cdr informed the group that the next meeting would be the Installation of Officers at 1800 hours, 14 August, 2019. He encouraged a good attendance for the meal and meeting.
4. The Finance Officer reported that a quote of \$7,800 plus the cost of permits was quoted for the first stage of roof repair. He added that a new commercial double fryer was donated to the kitchen by the caterer renting same. The caterer paid to have a conversion done from propane to natural gas and there remains a need to alter the fire suppression system to cover the device. An analysis of the current gas stove was conducted and it was deemed to be of higher quality than new models.
5. A further discussion included additional improvements to the building and the potential installation of awnings over the front windows on Alhambra Circle. A new exterior painting was also discussed as a potential improvement.
6. Joe Pigg mentioned the donation made to homeless veterans via the VA and that it was greatly appreciated. The Finance Office stated he had called the VA to determine what further items the vets needed and was waiting on a reply. Joe Pigg stated he would go there this week and make personal contact with the Volunteer Service Office to get a response.
7. The Commander adjourned the meeting at 1935 hours.
