When the Hopkinton dam was built, taking the farm where they spent summer vacations, they decided that it was time to buy a house in New Hampshire and Hillsborough had the one that they wanted. It was on a dirt road. No cars went by. A great place for young kids! How things have changed!!

When Hope moved here permanently, life included taking care of family, the community chorus with Phil Daley and hiking with the Harris center. The 1980's brought the start of her small flock of sheep and the journey to learn about animal husbandry and wool arts. Over the years she has raised many sheep and woven, spun, and knitted wool from them. Hope feels that it is very important to learn how to take care of farm animals. Weaver's Guild and, with Anne Hennessey of Antrim, started the long running Wool Tour which still runs today. Hope loves the out-of-doors and has a passion for learning.

Hope has eight living grandchildren (one granddaughter has passed), and four great grandchildren and loves rural life and the town she lives in. She was recently awarded the Hillsborough Boston Post Cane to share the honor with Gilman Shattuck. #### 2022 Matching Funds Challenge


