"Born in Massachusetts in 1939, Donald Palmer spent most of his youth growing up on a farm in Vermont, where he developed his strong work ethic and love for both the outdoors and animals.

Immediately after graduating high school, he enlisted in the United States Air Force and proudly served his country.

After leaving the Air Force and while traveling across the country, he met and soon married his wife Betty and began to settle down and start a family. Betty and Donald have two children, one grandchild, and one great grandchild.

After several relocations, as well as getting his degree in nursing and later graduating from New Hampshire Police Standards and Training, he worked and retired from the NH State Hospital as Deputy Chief of Security. Then he and his family finally settled down in the small country town of Windsor, New Hampshire in 1974, for which they still call home today."




