2021 PIT SPOT RULES

GENERAL INFORMATION

- Two types of pit spots are available to rent for the season:
 1. Pit spots without electricity - \$150
 2. Pit spots with electricity - \$275

PIT SPOT RULES ARE AS FOLLOWS:

- Day rates are available to racers for use of electrical. Racers must coordinate with an authorized track official for payment and access. Only racers **who have paid** for the pit spots with electricity are authorized to use the electrical source in their rented pit spot.
- For the Wabash Valley Dragway regularly scheduled races, rented pit spots are for the use of cars **that have** purchased a tech card and are eligible to race. Pit spot rentals are not honored during leased special events by outside promoters.
- It is expected that racers be courteous toward their neighbor by way of respecting boundaries and a driver's entrance/exit path to a pit spot. Wabash Valley Dragway drivers are professionals.
- Pit spots will be maintained, with all trash put in provided receptacles before leaving the premises, and all tools recovered from the grass. It is asked that drivers help to minimize damage to lawnmowers and/or prevent injury from flying metal.
- Overnight camping will be allowed. Individuals staying overnight **must** obtain new spectator and driver bands the following day. Campfires must be in a self-contained, raised fire pit: an on the ground fire ring is not acceptable.
- **There will be no dumping of any kind of waste from an RV or camper** – this includes 'gray water'. Violation of this rule will result in the racer **no longer** being allowed to bring an RV or camper on the racetrack grounds.

During the regular season, in the event the car count is higher than expected, Wabash Valley Dragway reserves the right to use leased pit spots that are not being used by a racer that has purchased a tech card that day. Size of the area needed will be taken in consideration when choosing these spots.

The facility unfortunately **no longer** has the room for open spectator parking. Wabash Valley Dragway is committed to drivers' and their racing needs, first and foremost. For safety and insurance reasons, parking is **no longer allowed on the north side of the return road as in the past.**
