A Living Hope Cont.

We are blessed to still be functioning at 100%. We know there are many ministries struggling and we do not take this for granted. We did stop our classes for about 4 months, but the ministry base remained open, and all our staff continued to work throughout the shutdown. Covid did not hit Haiti hard, and did not last long, and for that we are also blessed. We were not able to have any of our normal fundraisers we typically have during the year, yet we were fully funded for the year, and for that we are blessed. 2020 was the first full year of leadership classes, and those going through this intense class are coming out stronger and better prepared to be leaders in the Church. The discipleship class continues to flourish and we are now over 250 men and women graduating our discipleship school. We held 3 graduations in 2020.

The Haitian Harvest initiative continues to grow. We now have a great on line store and we are shipping products all over the US! We also planted another 3000 coffee seedlings this past year, including a new area called Fond De Negres. These seedlings will ensure sustainable income for mountain families, the church, and EDTC for many years to come, even generations! We were able to complete the translation of Discipleship Essentials thanks to Hansel Vedrine. The first translation was done by a group of people translating individually, so there was not good flow, and there were parts that were missing. Hansel meticulously re did the whole translation making sure the translation was interpreted in a way to be easily understood by the Haitians. Because of the quality of not just Discipleship essentials, but Leadership Essentials as well, we were able to publish the Creole version of both of these books, thanks to permission by Intervarsity Press and Greg Ogden. The books are now available for public sale in Haiti and the US through Halo Publishing. This is a huge answer to prayer as there has been a lot of demand for this curriculum in Haiti over the years, but due to our copyright agreement we could not distribute. Now it is available to anyone!

We were also able to add solar power to our ministry base to compliment the generator so we can be even more efficient. We were also able to complete the new dorms for leadership as well as renovate our kitchen, canteen, and add public bathrooms to the canteen area.

Ramase Lajan and the primary school also continue to thrive. Mission teams have been put on hold for the foreseeable future, but we pray we can start those soon.

Blessed. Blessed because of the living hope we have in Jesus Christ, and because of His call to make disciples in Haiti and the world. Blessed because of all our faithful supporters who believe in what EDTC is and what we are doing.
