## TODAY'S CONDITIONS

**FIRST RACE THE BONNERS AND BABLINGTON OWNER-TRAINER CONDITIONS RACE (LEVEL 3)**, Kindly sponsored by Bonners and Babington £150 to the winner, £80 to the second and £70 to the third, Mementoes to the winning Owner and Rider. For horses which on or since 1st October 2018 have not won any race under the Rules of any recognised Racing Authority (Point-to-Points excepted), nor any Mens, Ladies or Mixed Open Point-to-Point Steeplechase. Horses are to be owned and trained within immediate family members only, who have no more than five horses, of which only one may be trained for someone outside of the immediate family. Horses with keepers who are a licensed Trainer or have a Permit to train or have a licensed Trainer or Permit holder within their immediate family are not eligible for this race. Immediate family are only considered to be: Grandparents (Grandmother or Grandfather), Parent (Mother or Father), Child (Son or Daughter), Sibling (Brother or Sister) or spouse (Husband, Wife, Civil Partner of Co-Habitant by reason of a personal relationship). These conditions will be based on Keepers named on the first registered Hunter Certificate, unless the horse has been genuinely sold and dispensation sought. **Weights:** 12st for Horses and Geldings aged 5 years and older; 11st7lb for Mares of 5 years and older; 11st for 4-y-o Horses and Geldings; 10st7lb for 4-y-o Mares. **Penalties:** For each win on or since 1st October 2018 in an Intermediate or Conditions race (to include Confined, Club, Association, Service or Society Point-to-Point races, Maiden and Restricted races excepted) to carry 3lb extra. Maximum penalty to be carried is 10lb. **Penalties are cumulative**

**SECOND RACE THE FAROL LTD RESTRICTED RACE**, Kindly sponsored by Farol Ltd, £150 to the winner, £80 to the second and £70 to the third, Mementoes to the winning Owner and Rider. To be ridden by Gentlemen. **Weights:** 12st for Horses and Geldings aged 5 years and older; 11st7lb for Mares of 5 years and older; 11st for 4-y-o Horses and Geldings; 10st7lb for 4-y-o Mares. **Penalties:** A winner on or since 1st October 2019 to 30th September 2020 inclusive, of three or more eligible Steeplechase, Hurdle Race or Flat Races under the Rules of any recognised Racing Authority (Point-to-Points excepted) OR a winner of two eligible Steeplechase, Hurdle Race or Flat Races under the Rules of any recognised Racing Authority (Point-to-Points excepted) and one or more Mens, Ladies or Mixed Open Point-to-Point race in this period, to carry 5lb extra. Further penalties apply for wins on or since 1st October 2020 in an eligible Steeplechase or Hurdle race under the Rules of any recognised Racing Authority (Point-to-Points excepted) or in a Mens, Ladies or Mixed Open Point-to-Point; for one such win 3lb extra; for two such wins 5lb; for three or more such wins 7lb; maximum total penalty to be carried is 7lb.

Maximum penalty to be carried is 10lb. **Penalties are cumulative**

Maximum penalty to be carried is 10lb. **Penalties are cumulative**
