This is a one-day event. The winning High School team and winning Junior team will have the opportunity to represent Idaho at the 2023 BASS High School and Junior National Championship.

## Pre-fishing allowed until 6:00 pm July 9.

This is a 2 angler, team event. Each team consists of two students and must have an adult boat captain. Students must be an active member of B.A.S.S., and the Idaho B.A.S.S. Nation to be eligible to participate.

The team limit is 5 fish per day, and scores will be based on weight.

There is no entry fee for this tournament. However, the B.A.S.S. membership fee and Idaho B.A.S.S. Nation membership fee are \$10 each (\$20 total).
