



2026 Idaho Bass Nation State Championship Team Entry Form

When June 19th – 20th 2026 (Friday/Saturday)

Where: Lake Coeur d' Alene (Harrison Marina)

Check-in and Mandatory meeting 6 pm to 7 pm – The Draw will be at 7:00 p.m. June 18th Harrison Park.
This is a two-day event for the 2026 Idaho BASS Nation National Championship & 2027 Western Divisionals.

No off limits period

Entry Fee \$450 boater-\$300.00 non-boater

(\$10 per entry will be retained by the IBN to cover administration costs.)

CASH - Option Pots will be available at check in meeting - CASH ONLY !!!

Must be an active member of BASS, BASS Nation, The Idaho BASS Nation, and an Idaho BASS Nation affiliated club. (your local clubs can assist with all of these requirements except the BASS Membership.)

This is a Pro/AM event We request entries include a Boater & NON-Boater if possible. The parings will be a draw and rotate on day 2....

We will pay out the top 3 places in each category at a rate of \$150.00 per entry.

The remainder, \$300.00 Boater & \$150.00 Non-Boater, will be held for entry & travel to the 2027 Western Divisionals. (Minus any expenses incurred)

The Boater & Non-Boater will receive payment at the completion of the tournament weigh in.

The top 3 from each group will be given a spot into the 2026 Bass Nation - National Championship. The top 10 from each group will qualify for the 2027 IBN State Team to compete at the Western Divisionals.

State Team Purchase Benefits will be made available for these top qualifiers through the BASS the Alliance Program into 2026 & 2027.

Pre-registration is required.

To avoid a late fee you must sign up one **week prior** to the tournament (no later than June 15th).

Late entries will be accepted till 6 pm Mtn. Time Wednesday June 18th with a **\$50 Late Fee.**

Mandatory Pre-tournament check-in and meeting will be from 6pm - 8 p.m. PST Time (June 18th)

All Weights for the two-day event will be cumulative in determining the final positions.

This will be a team event. The Boater & Non boater will fish for a combined weight of 5 fish. On day 2 both the Boater & the Non-boater will carry this weight forward with their new partner on day two.

Total cumulative weight for the two days will determine the winners in both categories.

A separate Tournament Rules document will be provided at the check-in meeting.

All Participants MUST be paid members of an Idaho BASS Nation Club, which includes IBN & BN Membership dues.

Tournament Waters

Lake Coeurdalene – The lake is open water other than inside the marina, and Andersen Lake and Blue Lake in the Chain Lakes are off limits to all tournament fishing. You will be required to have IDFG license as well as a CDA Tribe permit.

All Idaho Bass Nation, Bass Nation, IDFG, & US Coast Guard regulations will be adhered to by all competitors.

We will pay out top 3 places in each category for 2026 National Championship at \$150.00 per entry. The remainder will be paid out to the top 10 in each category for the 2027 Western Divisional. The Boater & Non-Boater will receive payment at the tournament. (\$10 per entry will be retained by the IBN to cover administration costs.)

This will be a team event with each boater & non-boater carrying their combined weight for 5 fish to the following day to be combined with their 2nd day weight for their total weight for the event.

The advancement will be separate as a Boater and as a Non-Boater to the National Championship

Pre-registration is required.

To avoid a late fee you must sign up one week prior to the tournament (no later than June 15th).

Late entries will be accepted till 6 pm Mtn. Time, Thursday June 18th with a \$50 Late Fee.

Mandatory Pre-tournament check-in and meeting will be from 6pm - 8 p.m. Mtn Time (June 18th)

Teams will be drawn on day one and rotated on day two. Each member of the team will carry the combined weight of 5 fish forward through the tournament.

All Weights for the two-day event will be cumulative in determining the final positions.

Daily Bag Limit Per Boat is 5 fish – 12” or longer to be measured on a flat board with mouth closed. Tail fanning is permissible.

2026 National Championship positions. 3 boaters & 3 non-boaters will advance. Weights will be cumulative for 2 days.

All Participants MUST be a paid member of an Idaho BASS Nation Club, which includes Idaho Bass Nation & BN Membership.

2027 Western Divisional positions. 10 boaters & 10 non-boaters will advance to the Western Divisions in the spring of 2027 to compete for money and advancement to the 2027 National Championship. All Participants MUST be a paid member of an Idaho BASS Nation Club, which includes Idaho Bass Nation & BN Membership.

Tournament Waters

Lake Coeurdalene – The lake is open water other than inside the Harrison Marina, Andersen Lake and Blue Lake in the Chain Lakes are off limits to all tournament fishing.

You will be required to have IDFG license as well as a CDA Tribal fishing permit.

It is required that ALL BOATERS have a valid boater safety card. This will be required at the meeting the night before the event, or you may send a copy with your application. Also required is a copy of your boat insurance with a minimum of \$300,000.00 Liability Insurance.

Cash only option pot will be available at the Pre-tournament meeting
