Who uses Semaglutide High-Dose

- 1. Members after taking Mid-Dose but want more weight loss.
- 2. Members with high weight-loss goals and wish to lose weight fast.
- 3. Members who see that High-Dose is a great value for their investment.

Instructions. Fill each syringe to the unit line below. Note: 1ml = 100 units.

Members are initially shipped 3-months worth of Semaglutide PURE for the following doses.

If using High-Dose the first time after Mid-Dose, use the following dosing:

1-2	2 syringes	50 units	1.25mg			
3-4	2 syringes	60 units	1.5mg			
5-6	2 syringes	70 units	1.75mg

If already transitioned to High-Dose, use the following dosing:

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 Remember: Months are 4-weeks. Quarters are 3-months or 12-weeks. If you need extra syringes, order 1ml Insulin Syringes, 5/16" (8mm), 31G (.25mm) HERE.

Do not flush m	nedications or pour down a	drain.			
Use a Sharps	Container or a Bottle with C	ap to dispose of used syri	nges.		
Keep all medi	cines out of the reach of chi	ldren. Do not share or take	e anyone else's medicine.		

Side-effects may include nausea, acid reflux, diarrhea, constipation, and vomiting but usually decrease over time. See <u>MedPURE.com</u> for a more complete list and how to reduce them. Seek medical attention if severe abdominal pain or allergic reaction. Rodent studies have shown risk of Thyroid C-Cell Tumors (but not in human-studies).
