Note: New Tirzepatide is 2X the concentration as before and requires only $\frac{1}{2}$ the units for the same mgs.

Who uses Tirzepatide FAST-START Dosing

- 1. Members starting dual GLP-1 & GIP certified Tirzepatide to lose the most weight quickly.
- 2. Members seeking to minimize their side-effects as they lose weight.
- 3. In 3-months, Members titrate (increase dose) from start-dose of 2.5mg to 7.5mg at only \$195 a month.
- 4. After 3-months, Members may renew to Mid-Dose (5mg) at \$295, or increase to High-Dose (10mg) at \$495/mo.
- 5. After that, Members may renew to Super-Dose (12.5mg) at \$695/mo for fastest & greatest weight-loss.

Instructions. Fill each syringe to the unit line below. Note: 1ml = 100 units.

Members are initially shipped 3-months supply of Tirzepatide for the following doses:

Weeks #	# of syringes	<u>≈ Units per syringe</u>	≈ MG per syringe
1-4	4 syringes	12 units	2.5mg
5-8	4 syringes	25 units	5mg
9-12	4 syringes	37 units	7.5mg

Remember: The new units are ½ prior units due to 2X concentration.

Remember: Months are 4-weeks. 3 Months is 12 weeks.
Use MedPure's Dosing Calendar to write-down the units above on your inject-days.
Your initial shipment contains 3-Months (12 weeks) of Tirzepatide in vials and empty syringes.
Check all foil & paper wrapping for your vials and empty syringes.
To fill syringes, use <u>How to Fill Weight-Loss Syringes</u> and watch this <u>video</u> .
Refrigerate your vials & filled-syringes & vial(s) in a sealed plastic bag or a hard travel-case.
Immediately, or on your next inject-day, self-inject Week #1's syringe.
Use How to Self-Inject and watch this video.
Then, every 7-days (weekly), on your "inject-day," self-inject your next correctly-dosed syringe.
Properly discard any unused medication after 90 days. Do not reuse syringes.
Do not flush medications or pour down a drain.
Use a Sharps Container or a Bottle with Cap to dispose of used syringes.
Keep all medicines out of the reach of children.
Do not share or take anyone else's medicine.
