### Agenda

-Previous meeting minutes- Questions-Approval: motion to approve previous meeting minutes made by Mickey H., 2nd by Catherine C. All in favor.

-Treasures Report (Barbie)- bank balance \$17,616.90 as of 5/18/26. New sponsorships from AC Energy, AG West, Horse Plaza. The April show made a profit of \$2,298.00.

-New business preview

-New business to add: Barbie wanted to add business of discussing a clinic.

### Old Business

-501 situation update: 501, still has the same #. Need to complete the paperwork. \$0 fee on a postcard if we stay under \$50,000 annually.

-Storage?? storage unit? LaGene volunteered to call around and get quotes, she will report back to Casie. There was discussion of ORCHA buying a small storage trailer and hauling it to the shows.

-Abraham Cattle contract for 2025- According to our May 2025 meeting minutes; A change in cattle provider was determined due to Abraham charging \$1,300 in trucking, and the cattle contract btw ORCHA and Abraham stated it was only for the April 2025 show and not contracted for the entire 2025 show season. This was brought to the members attention and discussion closed.

-Future youth clinic in conjunction with a show. (Clinic on Friday, show on Saturday) BeefNW Sponsorship? -Joey hasn't heard back. Joey had an idea to invite Ag West to the Pendleton show (since they are located in Pendleton) and show them what is involved and propose we use their sponsorship of \$250 for the youth & Peewee buckles for the Aug show. Karen had mentioned that OR state fair is during the time of our Aug. show so those kids that will be showing will not be there. Motion made by

Joey to use Ag West's sponsorship for the Aug shows youth and peewee buckles. 2nd buy Billy W. All in favor, voted yes.

- Linda W. "What direction is the club headed? What direction are we taking?" Linda W. would like to see everyone get a prize/award at the end of year. This was discussed and it was agreed upon that the club is working on growing and working up. Catherine C added that it is headed in the right direction. Karen H asked if we would like to get to a certain dollar amount or end of year money. It was discussed that the next group of officers may lean towards NRCHA goals. This discussed was closed.

### New Business

-April Show Review - EOTEC- 4/25

-Show Budget- Casie presented with the treasures budget, after all expenses of judge, facility, cattle, and hauling. ORCHA profited \$2,298 for the April show.

-Cattle: Jake said to check back in July for cattle availability for Aug., it shouldn't be a problem but to double check. He said we have cattle for the June show.

-Did we like running drywork with cattle work? Keep the same or go back?  
Keep the same! All in favor and voted yes!

-Awards for cutting! Fees match other herd work (increased \$15)

-Ideas for AC Energy Sponsor \$ of \$2,250- discussed and decided during the board meeting to add \$1,000 added money to Open, NP, Cutting and Sr/Jr green horse divisions. Progressive payout, 2 entries \$100, 3 = \$150, 4 = \$250. Buckles to the high point 1K limited, Greener than Grass, and youth & peewee.

-Storage- getting quotes.

-Smaller battery PA (amazon \$160-\$300) Kelly D. said ORCHA has a small PA system and speaker at the club house at Sage Riders. We will check on that and get it when we gather our goods when we got a storage unit.

-Weekend Buckles- Open, NP, Cutting-Open & NP, 1K, GTG, SR, JR, Youth, PW (Ordered for 1k, gtg, youth and pw) \$370.

-Judge Cory Shelman, Elane has discussed with him about possibly having a kids clinic on the day before... he was up for it. Discussed a 2 hr clinic on friday night for

Reminder-

\*when entering Greener than grass (<\$250), \$1K Limited, points=\$ plus jackpot

\*Rule passed at 12.2025 Meeting: If a contestant is entering Fence Work, they are not eligible for points/year end awards in boxing or box drive on the same horse at any level. You may still enter for schooling.

\*You can enter your eligible class or a higher class.

\*You must attend 2 out of the 3 shows and enter the same classes at 2+ shows to qualify for end of year awards in a class.

\*There must be 3 or more entries in a class to be eligible for end of year awards (with the exception of all youth and all peewee classes).

\*Rule Review:

-There must be three or more entries for each class for that class's points to count for year end awards. Ex: 3 entries show 1, good -2 entries show two, no points towards awards, -show three 2 entries- no awards for year end
