On March 22, 23, Co-founders of AARS Ret. Col. Bryan Denny and Kathy Waters headed to DC for their fifth time to educate lawmakers on the need for safer platforms and how the scams affect not only their constituents but the entire world. We met with the legislative staffs of Senator Padilla, Senator Feinstein, and Senator Durbin. On the final day we met with Congressman Valadeo's office. Congressman Valadeo made a point to introduce himself to Bryan and Kathy and speak from a personal standpoint of how a similar scam affected his family.



His legislative staff is very interested in moving forward with a bill on safer platforms and we were thrilled to help educate on the matter and really show the need for new laws.

Also during the visit, we had the opportunity to meet with Donna Gregory, Unit Chief of the Internet Crimes Complaint Center (IC3). Ms. Gregory was insightful on the reporting process and was very interested in the work we do and the guidance we are able to provide. The meeting was approximately an hour and a half of solid scam fighting talk! It was fantastic!



Operation Shamrock is a collaboration of law enforcement, social media companies, banks, advocates, diplomats, blockchain analytics firms and many more to help bring the attention to the subject of Pig Butchering, and make people recognize just how destructive and massive this problem is. Initiated by Ms. Erin West, a Santa Clara Prosecuting Attorney specializing in crypto currency scams, she has formed a project with the hopes of helping hundreds of thousands, if not millions! Ms. West's motto for #Operationshamrock: Educate. Seize. Disrupt.

As mentioned in the prior newsletter, Pig Butchering is the combination of a romance scam, and investment scam resulting is some of the largest losses from scams known to date. GREAT NEW TOOLS!

This past month we were introduced to a few new tools that can help people combat scammers.

The first tool brought to AARS's attention was the by the The Dark Night Online (TDNO). They provide a service ran by Facecheck.ID that has the ability to read a photo with the potential of finding the same person throughout the world wide web. This tool can help see if the researched photo has been used under different names, accounts or even in educating others on scams.

The second tool we had the privilege to try was <u>Scam Rangers</u> message verification. This exciting new option gives you the opportunity to plug in a message you think may be sent by a scammer to verify if the message is a high, medium, or low risk for scamming.

Keep in mind, to determine a scam, never use just one way to verify. But these tools are a great start!
