

# RECEIVING BLANKETS & BURP CLOTHS

To make ONE receiving blanket (36 x 36 inches) and TWO burp cloths, you'll need:

- 1 yard EACH of two (2) coordinating flannels - total of 2 yards of flannel.
- #10 Knit crocheting thread
- Metal Crocheting Hook # 7 or # 8

## STEPS:

1. Cut out a 36in x 36in square from each piece of flannel.
2. Depending on the width of the fabric, you'll have a 7-8 inch piece of fabric left over. Use the width left over and cut rectangles about 22 inches long. Making 2 from each fabric for a total of four (4) 7 - 8 in x 22 in. of fabric.
3. Place wrong sides together of each blanket and burp cloths.
4. Round the corners: Using an 8 inch circle ruler or a plate, mark all four corners of blanket and burp cloths, making sure that you use the same measurement in each corner.
5. Using a serger, serge all the way around the entire square and the two burp cloths.
6. Send them to hemstitcher.
7. When you get it back from hemstitcher, crochet the edges.
