



Backpacks Materials

- 1. Prepared Fabric (18x45)**
- 2. Paracording x 2 (54 inches long)**
- 3. Clip Threader**
- 4. Small Ruler**
- 5. Straight Pins**
- 6. Sewing Machine**
- 7. Surger**
- 8. Thread**
- 9. Scissors**



Sewing Backpacks

- 1. Sew a 1” casing on both edges of serged fabric.**
- 2. Take a threaded backpack with cording. Untie the loose knot, slightly pull cording so it will be easier to sew.**
- 3. From bottom sew side seam up 4”, place cording so it can be caught in the seam allowance. Backstitch and finish sewing sides seams up to the casing and backstitch.**



Threading Backpack Instructions

- 1. Using the clamp threader tool, thread the first piece of paracord through one casing and continue through the second casing making a U-turn.**
- 2. Tie ends together in a loose knot.**
- 3. Repeat step one for the second piece of cording, **EXCEPT** start threading on the side of the U-turn.**
- 4. Tie ends together in a loose knot.**
- 5. Stack in a pile to be sewn.**
