

MEMORANDUM

Re: Environmental Assessments and Comments Concerning:

Town of Long Lake Proposed Local Law for Battery Energy Storage Systems (BESS), and

Town of Long Lake Opt-Out from Real Property Law § 487 for certain Energy Related

Improvements

The Town Board is considering the enactment of two local laws.

Proposed Local Law # 1 of 2023 establishes a regulatory and permitting system for Battery Energy Storage Systems that applicants may wish to site within the Town.

Proposed Local Law #2 of 2023 would exercise a state law provision allowing municipalities to "Opt-Out" of 15 year real property exemptions for certain renewable energy and energy storages systems (this does not affect exemption for residential solar systems provided for under RPTL § 487-a.

I am attaching Part 1 of the Short Environmental Assessment Forms for each law along with the text of both laws as proposed at the March 29th Board Meeting.

The BESS Law is based upon a model local law provided by NYSERDA. The model law and the New York State Battery Energy Storage System Guidebook are on NYSERDA's website https://www.nyserda.ny.gov/All-Programs/Clean-Energy-Siting-Resources/Battery-Energy-Storage-Guidebook

The purpose and rationale for instituting such a law are provided in the attached documents.

Your comment and input into the environmental review process is requested. The Town Board is conducting a hearing at 7 pm on Thursday April 20th at the Town Hall to receive public comment. Comment is requested by the end of the day on April 19th in writing to me.
