

The new budget 2021-2027

European Union (EU) budget is a multi-annual financial framework with a 7-year cycle. This new budget is essential to finance policies carried out at European level such as agriculture, regional development, space, transport-European networks, research and innovation, health, education and culture, migration, border protection humanitarian and more. It is financed by the contributions of the member states and by customs duties. Below we'll take a closer look at how this budget was divided and where to find funding for civil society organizations working on the rule of law, access to justice and fundamental human rights.

Budget Heading

The budget is organized around 7 headings. They are listed below and highlighted are those that are the most relevant:.

1. Single Market, Innovation and Digital

This first heading of the funding program focuses on promoting and assisting research, innovation, and numerical transition. A portion of this budget is available for strategic investments in areas like transport, energy and digital.

2. Cohesion, resilience, and values

The second heading will play a principal role in the implementation of the EU's landmark recovery instrument. Trough financing system the EU wants to help all the regional policy, justice, rights and at the same time, financing is provided for everything that takes part of the social policy.

3. Natural resources and environment

This heading covers the common agricultural policy (offers direct aid to farmers and market measure), climate action and protection of the environment as well as biodiversity.

4. Migration and border management

This aid/financing allows to improve the reception of asylum seekers, the implementation of integration measures. It also allows the members states to have a better control of their external borders of the EU and to have the control of migrants and asylum of migrants who gets in. On the other hand, the funds for border protection will help member state in maintaining their sovereignty and shares responsibility in securing the external borders of the Union. All this while respecting the free movement of people in the EU.

5. Security and defense

This heading is dedicated in the internal protection of Europe, preventing and combating terrorism and radicalization, large, organized crime, and cybersecurity. Here we also find the European defense, a budget that allows to reinforce the competitiveness, the efficiency, and the industrial and technological base in the defense.

6. Neighborhood and the world

The sixth heading try to finance the actions of the neighborhood and cooperation in the international development. A part of the funding is reserved for humanitarian aid. Also aid to help these countries in the pre-accession to join the 27.

7. European public administration

The last heading includes the administrative costs of the European Institutions, the cost for the European Schools and the retirement.
