Information We May Collect

We may collect and process the following personal information:

Personal Identification Information

- Full name
- Email address
- Telephone number
- Date of birth or age confirmation where required

Booking Information

- Event bookings
- Membership information
- Payment confirmation details
- Attendance records

Communication Information

- Messages sent via email or social media
- Customer enquiries
- Feedback or complaints

Media Content

- Photographs or videos taken during events

Technical Information

If using a website or online booking system, we may collect:

- IP address
- browser type
- device information
- cookies or website usage data

How We Use Your Information

We may use your personal information to:

- process event bookings and memberships;
- communicate important event information;
- respond to enquiries;
- manage memberships and attendance;
- improve our services and events;
- ensure safety and security at events;
- comply with legal obligations; and
- promote Surrey Girls Socials through photographs, videos, and social media content where appropriate.

Lawful Basis for Processing

Under UK GDPR, we rely on the following lawful bases for processing personal data:

Contractual Necessity

To fulfil bookings, memberships, and event-related services.

Legitimate Interests

To operate and improve Surrey Girls Socials safely and effectively.

Legal Obligations

To comply with applicable laws and regulations.

Consent

Where consent is required, such as certain marketing communications or specific media usage.

Photography and Video

Photographs and videos may be taken during events for promotional and marketing purposes, including use on:

- social media;
- websites;
- promotional materials; and
- advertising content.

By attending events, attendees acknowledge that photography or filming may take place.

If you do not wish to appear in photographs or videos, please notify us prior to the event and we will make reasonable efforts to accommodate your request.

Surrey Girls Socials is not responsible for photographs or content shared independently by attendees or third parties.

How We Store Your Information

We take reasonable steps to protect your personal information from:

- unauthorised access;
- loss;
- misuse;
- disclosure; or
- alteration.

Information may be stored electronically using password-protected systems and secure platforms.

We retain personal information only for as long as reasonably necessary for:

- operational purposes;
- legal obligations;

- accounting requirements; or
- dispute resolution.

Sharing Your Information

We do not sell personal information to third parties.

Information may be shared where necessary with:

- booking or payment providers;
- venues hosting events;
- professional advisers;
- legal authorities where required by law; or
- service providers assisting with business operations.

Any third parties used are expected to handle data securely and lawfully.

Marketing Communications

We may occasionally contact you regarding:

- upcoming events;
- memberships;
- promotions; or
- Surrey Girls Socials updates.

You may opt out of marketing communications at any time by:

- contacting us directly; or
- using any unsubscribe option provided.

Your Rights

Under UK GDPR, you may have the right to:

- access your personal data;

- request correction of inaccurate information;
- request deletion of your information;
- restrict or object to processing;
- withdraw consent where applicable; and
- lodge a complaint with the Information Commissioner's Office (ICO).
