JOB ANNOUNCEMENT

Line Service Technician I

(Full-Time Position / 40 Hours Weekly)

Note: Employee must complete NATA Safety First training within six months of start date.

Hours: Rotating schedule. Business hours M-F 7am-7pm, and Sat-Sun 8am-5pm.

Pay Range: Starting Pay \$14.50 / hr.

Note: Pay increases for full-time Line Service Technicians \$14.50 / hr. - \$18.50 / hr.

<u>Job Duties:</u> The purpose of this position is to learn and perform all facets of Line Service operations. This includes fueling aircraft, routine airport maintenance, and other duties as assigned. This position will work under the Supervisor, Airport Services. Employee shall fully learn the trade of aircraft refueling to include how to operate nozzles, measure fuel quantities in storage, check fuel quality, and interact with pilots and aircraft.

PHYSICAL DEMANDS: The physical demands described here represent those that must be by an employee in order to successfully perform the daily functions of this job. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable employees with disabilities to perform the daily functions. During the performance and duties of this position, the employee is frequently required to stand, walk, sit, and use hands to handle or feel objects, tools, or controls; reach with hands and arms; and talk or hear. The employee is occasionally required to climb or balance and stoop, kneel, crouch, or crawl. The employee must occasionally lift and or move up to 30 pounds.

<u>Requirements</u>: Applicants must have a minimum of a standard high school diploma or GED. Current or past involvement in aviation is a plus, but not required. This position is outdoors and in all weather conditions. Must possess a valid driver's license. This position is subject to drug screening. Ideal applicant will have very good communication skills and high-level work ethic.

<u>Benefits</u>: Retirement Plan (Retirement Systems of Alabama, RSA), and health benefits are offered for full-time employees after a probationary period. Major holidays paid.
