THE Cello BUGGIE User Guide

Congratulations on the purchase of your Cello Buggie!

Designed specifically for the cello, it can also be used to transport a guitar. Use either with or without a soft gig bag. Transporting your instrument has never been easier or safer for your instrument!

Setting up your Cello Buggie is simple!



STEP 1

Place the cello on its side and place the plastic loop over the endpin.



STEP 2

With cello on its side, place chassis along top side of instrument pulling it taut.



STEP 3

Bring bungee cord around neck. Secure ball end to bungee buckle hook.



STEP 4

Once it's all securely attached, it's ready to roll!

Additional adjustments

The key to having the cello stand upright on its own is to adjust the distance between the plastic loop and the Cello Buggie's body so that the cello is balanced when standing.*

The Cello Buggie is not intended to be used as a stand and should not be left unattended.



Using with a gig bag

Place the securing straps of the Cello Buggie around the cello at a slightly higher position just below the heel of the neck of the cello. (See photo above). It can also be used with or without a soft instrument bag.
