User Guide

Congratulations on your purchase of the original Bass Buggie®! Its easy-to-use design adjusts to fit any size double bass and can be used with or without a gig bag. Transporting your double bass has never been easier.

Setting up your Bass Buggie® simple!



STEP 1

Place the bass on its side and place the plastic loop over the endpin.



STEP 2

With bass on its side, place chassis along top side of bass pulling it taut.



STEP 3

Bring bungee cord around neck. Secure ball end to bungee buckle hook.



STEP 4

Once it's all securely attached, it's ready to roll!



Additional adjustments

The key to having the bass stand upright on its own is to adjust the distance between the plastic loop and the Bass Buggy's body so that the bass is balanced when standing.*



*The Bass Buggy® is not intended to be used as a stand and should not be left unattended.

Using with a gig bag

Place the securing straps of the Bass Buggy® around the bass at a slightly higher position just below the heel of the neck of the bass. (See photo above). It can also be used without a gig bag.

Optional accessory

Bass Buggy® Cushion

The Bass Buggy® Cushion helps absorb shock when traveling over rough surfaces. It's a great addition to the Bass Buggy®.

Made of closed cell black neoprene, the cushion adheres directly on to the Bass Buggy®.



Remove paper backing from the adhesive and place adhesive side down onto the cradle of the Bass Buggy®.
