We, here at NorCal Trykers, have all remained well and have continued to donate trykes to children with special needs. All evaluations and fittings have been done outside, with all precautions taken.

We donated more trykes in 2020 than in previous years, 70 in total!! This year is proving to be more challenging as the supply of trykes from Taiwan has slowed us down. We are doing all we can to provide an efficient service, but the supply issue has created a lot of frustration. We thank our families for their continued patience.



There are many things to be grateful for and one of them is our assessment trailer. We received it in mid-February, having ordered it about a year ago (Covid delays!!!) We are thrilled with it and have so many plans. Our immense gratitude to Woodland Sunrise Rotary for awarding us this grant (see the section on Tryke Days in this newsletter)

Another enormous debt of gratitude goes to our amazing volunteer, Jim Kocsis of Davis. He is running our Re-Cycle program and has upgraded many trykes now, allowing us to re-issue them. He has also organized all our spare parts and made an effective inventory. This allowed us to donate many trykes over the summer that were missing a key component (Jim managed to assemble the missing items from the myriad of spare parts hiding in our storage unit!!)

#### INTRODUCING TRYKE DAYS!!!

W e are so excited to announce a development in our service to families of children with special needs.

Due to a generous grant, awarded to us by Woodland Sunrise Rotary, we have been able to purchase a 16 foot box trailer. This trailer will be stocked with samples of all the trykes that Amtryke manufactures, along with all the accessories and adaptations.

We plan to hold "Tryke Days" 4 times a year, with the first one scheduled for Saturday, April 3rd, held at the Northern California Children's Therapy Center, 1321 College Street, Woodland.

Families will be invited to come along for the following reasons:

- 1. New applicants can try out a variety of trykes, ensuring we order the most appropriate setup
- 2. Families can bring their child's tryke to repair or replace a broken part
- 3. Families can bring their child and tryke for a sizing evaluation. If the tryke can be enlarged to allow further use, we can do that, or we can evaluate the child for the next size up (upcycle).

We are so grateful to Woodland Sunrise Rotary for facilitating this development in our program.
