Applicant must provide verification of enrollment and have a minimum grade point average of 2.5 (as applies). Lump sum payment will be made payable to the student pending verification of school enrollment.

INSTRUCTIONS AND DOCUMENTS REQUIRED FOR SUBMISSION

1. A letter of recommendation from a LACCEA member
2. A copy of your high school or college transcript
3. A copy of your college/school acceptance or admission letter. Current college students, submit registration for upcoming semester or quarter.
4. Verified minimum grade point average of 2.5 for university, junior college, community college, or trade school students.
5. Essay must be one-page, typed, double-spaced, in Times New Roman size 12-point font, and based on selection of scholarship (see application).
6. All applications must have original signatures where required. Entries will be considered incomplete if a required signature is missing.
7. Entire application (including essay) must be submitted upon the deadline.
8. Application must be received no later than 4:00pm on Friday, July 10, 2020 to be considered.
