Liability Agreement: We, the undersigned, fully understand that we are boarding a boat fishing vessel to fish in open water. I understand and assume the risks and hazards associated with inshore and offshore fishing. These risks and hazards include, but are not limited to, the following: Sun, rain, lightning, sea spray, and any other weather conditions; sea sickness; pitching and rolling; slippery and wet decks; injuries, internal or external, from: boarding and disembarking the vessel; fish, fishing, fishing tackle, and gear; and the unintentional conduct of any other persons on the boat.

I understand and agree that I will not hold the Captain and Crew liable for risks and hazards associated with inshore or offshore fishing, and I expressly release them from all such risks and hazards.

(21+) Beer is permitted on the trip. No liquor, please. Beer MUST be cans; NO bottles are permitted per Coast Guard regulations. Please limit your alcohol consumption. We believe 100% in being safe and responsible on the water. Your Captain and mate will never have so much as a drop of alcohol on your trip. Absolutely NO DRUGS of ANY sort! The last thing I want is to cut the trip short and call the Coast Guard for them to meet you at the dock.

Drugs: ZERO TOLERANCE Under NO circumstances are illegal substances permitted on board. Any passenger bringing illegal substances on board will be held responsible for all damages that may be caused by such action, including but not limited to: entire cost of vessel due to confiscation by authorities, loss of income due to vessel down time, liability for injuries, legal fees incurred by all parties, etc. Our captains are bound by USCG rules to immediately report all possession of illegal substances to authorities, who will meet us at the dock or board us on the water to take further action.

Medical Marijuana: Please note that while marijuana is medically legal in Florida, is not legal on the federal level and Marijuana is not permitted on board in any form (even with a medical prescription). As a Federally Documented and licensed vessel we are bound by Federal law (not state law). DO NOT BRING IT WITH YOU!

Moreover, I am not in possession of any illegal substances, and I release the Captain and Crew from any liability whatsoever for any illegal actions taken by myself on the vessel. INITIALS OF PARTY REPRESENTATIVE: _____

What is included in your trip: You are more than welcome to bring your own gear if you'd like. If not, I can provide you all the gear, bait, fuel, and ice necessary to supply your day of fishing. What is NOT included: Beverages and food are not supplied. (We always have water on board). If bringing sandwiches, we suggest you place them in Ziplock bags to ensure dryness.

Life Jackets: As a USCG certificated vessel, we have enough life jackets on board for all passengers and crew. If you're cruising with children and are more comfortable bringing their own life jackets, please do so.

Shoes: Please wear shoes that are soft-soled and have light bottoms (boat shoes, sneakers, etc.) Guests wearing high heels or dark-soled shoes will be asked to remove them prior to boarding the vessel. As the deck can get hot during the summer months, it's not recommended to go barefoot, so please plan accordingly.

Sea sickness: Sea sickness can occur to anyone; we suggest that anyone who has even the slightest concern about being seasick takes an over-the-counter motion sickness medicine prior to departure. It's cheap insurance to make sure you have the most enjoyable day on the water.

If the captain cancels the charter due to weather or any other reason, you will receive a complete 100% refund.

Gratuities are expected and greatly appreciated. If the captain and his mate did a good job, made the trip enjoyable and you had a good time you might consider rewarding those efforts. 15%-20% is standard.
