Texas AFL-CIO Action Plan: Special Session Redistricting

Context: Governor Greg Abbott has called a 30-day special session of the Texas Legislature, which is set to begin on Monday, July 21.

But instead of focusing on emergency preparedness or helping Central Texans recover from the July 4 flooding, Abbott and his followers are playing politics. They want state lawmakers to take on redrawing Congressional districts — known as "redistricting" — to help certain lawmakers win elections over others.

Multiple public hearings will be held at the state Capitol and within the Congressional Districts that will be targeted in these redistricting efforts. The Texas Labor Movement must be ready to respond in force to the attacks on our democratic processes and push back on these partisan maps that lock in control for Trump, Abbott, and their allies. Texas workers in these affected communities need to be prepared to show up in person to fight Trump and Abbott's scheme to take over our state.

Objectives:

- Demonstrate significant opposition to partisan redistricting efforts
 - Testimony at the Capitol during legislative hearings
 - Attendance at the Capitol during opposition actions
 - Testimony at hearings in Houston and North Texas from union members and their family members who would be impacted by the proposed maps
 - o A petition in opposition
 - Social media messaging/awareness
- Coordinate with central labor body leaders in affected regions to mobilize members and workers to attend actions
- Coordinate with partners and allied organizations to align on messaging and actions to mobilize around
- Mobilize 40-50 people/members at each event to oppose redistricting efforts
- Identify people/members to testify at each hearing

- o Austin 5 people
- o Houston and Arlington 15 people at each

Proposal: Rapid response mobilization effort in coordination with allied organizations and central labor bodies to have a presence at hearings and show widespread opposition to partisan redistricting efforts. Efforts will include turnout to hearings and actions, digital awareness and engagement, and identifying people/members in affected districts to testify publicly.
