



Dark Mother, grant me entrance Into your secret lair, Shine your torch light To the inner chamber Where your eternal cauldron Of rebirth resides. I come, as has been so since before time, To be undone Reduced to my soul fire, To be rebuilt in truth.

# Praeparatio Animarum Renovamen: Getting Ready for The Rebirth Ceremony

I liken The Rebirth Ceremony to a giant cauldron, a sort of well right in front of the Death Queen herself. The moon rises and sets in it, and it is guarded by her powerful companions. While this is an immensely personal journey, I've provided a ritual for you to follow, adapt as you feel led or do as is.

#### **Preparations**

At this stage of the journey, you may well be feeling ready to give birth to the new you. The largeness<sup>1</sup> inside of you may be ready to burst out. Stay with the daily ritual to keep you grounded and centered.

#### **Aevitas**

<u>Timing</u>: We perform The Animarum Renovamen (The Rebirth Ceremony) on the New Moon of Aries, drawing upon the energy of the rebirthing verdant world.

<u>Symbol</u>: I recommend adorning yourself with a key to symbolize opening the gate to your new life.

#### Anassa

<u>Offering</u>: The Anassa Eneroi Casket, the Kalos Thanatos Poppet, with the Negative Confessions on the Rose of Rebirth are our offerings.

# Magikeia

<u>Phos Renovamen</u>: A white candle adorned with symbols appropriate for rebirth, including The Rebirth Sigil, in addition to crafting The Anassa Eneroi Casket.

#### Medela

<u>Color</u>: White, which symbolized death in some ancient locations associated with Hekate, which heals through purification and ascension. A key with white cord can be prepared for adornment upon completion of the ceremony.

#### Pharmakeia

Aster, birch, lavender, mugwort, oak, pomegranate, and rose are rebirth botanicals. This year we are focusing on rose. Learn more about them, and other plant spirit companions for the rebirth process in *Entering Hekate's Garden*. We are focusing on rose, as a botanical of both love and death. There is also a version of the rebirth ceremony as a ritual bath in that book.<sup>2</sup>

For the Khernips component of the ceremony, a sprig of lavender is recommended. Substitutions can be rosemary or juniper.

You can use the Hekate's Cauldron incense in a small cauldron for all the pieces of The Rebirth Journey, from the Transmuting Shame to Truth Project to the live ceremony.

**Oleum Spirita:** As with the prior ceremonies, the Oleum Spirita is integral to the experience.

#### Sibylika

You should complete part 1 and The Cauldrons of Rebirth reading series prior to the ritual. The Cauldrons of Kore/Rebirth reading is suitable for after.

#### **Spirita**

Avian Ally: By now you may have a close bond with your winged companion. Be sure to honor them anew as you prepare for the ceremony.

<u>Animal Guide</u>: Goat, as a creature that traverses all three worlds, from Temple to Cave and Garden betwixt, is a steadfast companion to connect with during the Rebirth Journey.

<u>Hekate's Stones</u>: Set the altar with all the stones of the journey (i.e., all the stones you've studied in Covina), adding moonstone as a symbol of transcendence, which is the energy of the process of psychospiritual dismemberment and death. Moonstone is a stone of initiation and wholeness, and you can adorn yourself with one to signify the completion of the journey. Obsidian is an excellent protective ally for rebirth<sup>3</sup> and I recommend placing it at the center of the arrangement, next to a piece of selenite<sup>4</sup>, which will help invigorate your new life after the ceremony (it is the stone of Kore).

The Altar: a rebirth altar is both a reflection of bringing death and the beginning of a new phase. Symbols of both can be included in the altar. You may want to create a special shrine to your avian companion in honor of their diligent support during your journey.

# Phos Renovamen: Crafting The Light of Rebirth

The Light of Rebirth (Phos Renovamen) is a candle used to ignite the rebirth process.

## **Supplies**

- A white pillar candle
- A base for the candle, such as a white plate or bowl
- Rose in some form (dried or oil preferably)
- Paint markers, etc. for vivifying the candle
- Oleum Spirita
- Moonstone
- A symbol of your Avian Ally

# **Technique: Enchanting Through Candle Dressing**

The technique we'll be using is described in detail in *Entering Hekate's Garden: The Magick, Medicine and Mystery of Plant Spirit Witchcraft:* 

Begin by cleansing the candle from miasma, if necessary, by rubbing with salt or soil. Then attune the candle for pharmakeia by using a fixative like olive oil, concentrating on adding the powers of the fixative to the candle as you rub. Use a clockwise circular motion for attraction workings, a counterclockwise motion for removals, and alternate between the two for spells that are a combination.

Cover the candle in your chosen botanicals, ensuring that the blend is ground small. Larger pieces can flare up when the candle is burning, especially if it is a narrow taper. Spread the blend on a piece of parchment and mix in a bit of the fixative, just barely coating the botanicals. Roll the candle back and forth across the blend, concentrating on activating the powers of the plant spirits and directing them into the candle. Then wrap the candle tightly in the parchment and roll some more. With pillar candles, you can apply more force, so that the botanicals really merge into the candle. Once you are happy with the appearance, wrap the candle again until it's time to use it. You can add a protective black cloth as well.

You can adorn your candle with Hekate's Cauldron Incense, rose petals and even moonstone chips using the above technique. Replace the black cloth with white, if you are storing it prior to the vivification ritual below.

As for the vivification symbols, they can be added directly to the candle or on the vessel.

#### **Animarum Phos Renovamen: Vivification Protocol**

#### **Timing**

Either The New Moon or the Full Moon prior to the ritual.

#### **Procedure**

Place the candle on your altar.

I call to Anassa Eneroi and her companions, I speak this candle to life this night.

Write the date on the bottom of the candle.

Hold candle at Crown, and speak:

To the Moon Lighting The Night, I call you down into this candle.

Inscribe a symbol of The Moon onto the candle.

To Anassa Eneroi and her companions.

To Luna,
Light and dark,
Bring balance to me,
Illumination and mystery,
Discovery and security,
As I journey through Rebirth.

Apply the Rebirth sigil to the candle or the vessel.

Place candle on altar and ignite, then recite in front of it:

I summon my avian ally (use specific name or species) Become my companion on this Rebirth Journey.

Add a symbol to the candle or keep nearby.

Proceed immediately into the Phos Renovamen Quotidia.

#### **Phos Renovamen Quotidia**

The Phos Renovamen Quotidia begins upon vivification and should be maintained for at least one week after the Rebirth ceremony.

### To perform the ritual:

The best procedure is to do this immediately after the Hieros Pyr component of our regular Quotidia. Once complete, continue onto the usual meditation, allowing the energy of the Beacon to work on you, and then finishing with the Enodia Oracle.

Ignite the Beacon.

Speak out the invocation at the beginning of this Compendia (3 x), and then add:

*I claim rebirth as mine* (say it three times.) Then recite your Negative Confessions, or work on them, etc. Pay attention to the images that come through in meditation, and the messages the cards bring.
