

RESTORING FELON RIGHTS

(AMENDMENT 3)

The Proposed Amendment restores a felon's rights:

- **Without** a case-by-case review.
- **Immediately** upon leaving incarceration.
- **Without** the offender paying his/her debt to society.
- **Without** restitution to the offender's victim.
- **Without** regard to whether the offense was violent or non-violent.
- **Regardless** of whether the felon shows remorse.
- **Regardless** of whether the felon makes any effort toward rehabilitation.
- **Regardless** of whether the felon successfully completed probation

Currently there is a case-by-case individual review by the Governor before restoring a felon's right to vote, to run for office, or sit on a jury.

Restoration is only granted when deemed appropriate.

The Governor's individual review includes all items noted above.
