



2024 PLC CREATIVE ART ENTRIES



The Creative Arts Festival has been a well-loved tradition for many years in the Antiochian Orthodox Christian Archdiocese of North America, including here at St. George.

Each year the Archdiocese selects a new theme for the Festival, and students in almost 300 parishes across the United States and Canada use their creativity to make projects based on the theme in the categories of Art, Poetry, Creative Writing, and Photography. The theme for 2024 was Romans 8:28, "All things work together for good to those who love God, to those who are the called according to His purpose."

Many St. George Sunday School students attended our Creative Arts workshops this past spring, and 66 beautiful projects were completed. These projects were sent to the 2024 Parish Life Conference host parish for judging (St. Stephen Church in Hiram, Georgia.) St. George Sunday School has the highest rate in the Diocese of Miami and the Southeast of students submitting entries in multiple categories. On Sunday, September 8, the efforts of our beloved students were recognized during an awards ceremony following the Divine Liturgy.

Thank you, Dn. Raphael, Anna Sarah Farah, Sunday School teachers, and St. George families for encouraging our students to express their Faith through the arts. Students, congratulations and well done!



St. George of Jacksonville Funeral Traditions: "A Guide"

This manual of policies and procedures has been prepared for all members of our beloved St. George Church and Community. This policy is **still being implemented** *(into effect)* until now.

The Orthodox funeral service emphasizes the reality of death and the new life of the deceased. It is a compassionate and beau-

tiful service which features prayers for forgiveness and mercy from God for the departed's soul.

Eastern Orthodox Funeral service is composed of four (4) parts:

- 1. Trisagion prayers
- 2. Funeral Service
- 3. Interment at the cemetery
- 4. Mercy Meal after Burial Service

The Rite at the Time of Death: After Death Has Occurred

After death has occurred, the priest should be immediately notified (ASAP)

LITURGICAL EXPRESSION

A. Place of Service: Orthodox **Funerals** must take place within the Church.

B. Day of Service: (ONE DAY SERVCIE)

Since 2021-Visitations and Funeral Services have been held on the **same day** at St. George Church.

FROM NOW ON, we will continue the same traditional way of having a **One Day Service** for all departed Orthodox members of St. George Church and is as follows:

- Viewing / Visitation: 10:00 am to 11:00 am (Prior Funeral)
- Funeral Service begins at 11:00 am–(Followed by Eulogies)

• Interment Service, a Trisagion Prayers, at the graveside (after Funeral)

•Mercy Meal (after Interment)

Please note: If the family requested to have an extra time for ***Visitation/Viewing** on the **evening** of **(day before)** the funeral service, it **must be** arranged and **done** at the funeral home.

C. Orthodox Funeral Traditions

- The body of a *departed communicant* of the Church should be brought into the church on the **day** of burial.
- Burials *may not be* celebrated on Sundays during the year.
- Burials *should not be celebrated* on Great Feast days and the body should not be brought into the church.
- Burials *may not be celebrated* on Holy Friday, Holy Saturday, or the Sunday of Pascha. The body is not brought into the church on those days.

D. Donation in Memory

In lieu of flowers, donations may be made in honor of your departed loved ones to Saint George Orthodox Church.

E. Interment.

Once at the cemetery, a short graveside burial service is performed by the priest. The Trisagion is again recited.

F. Post-Funeral Reception

After the body is buried, family and friends gather for a reception, where mourners can connect with each other, reflect on the life of the deceased, and eat a meal, called a "*mercy meal.*"

G. Memorial Services

It is the custom now at our St. George church to have memorial services on the **40th**, **6** months, and **1** year after death. The day of death is counted as the **first** day.

Memorial services **are not celebrated from Palm Sunday to New Sunday (Thomas Sunday)**


