

TOWN OF TWO CREEKS - MANITOWOC COUNTY APPLICATION FOR CULVERT PERMIT

NOTE: You must obtain a permit for the Culvert from the Department of Natural Resources, Contact the Green Bay Office at 920-662-5472 - takes up to 30 days for a permit.

NOTE: This permit is good for 1 year from date of issue.

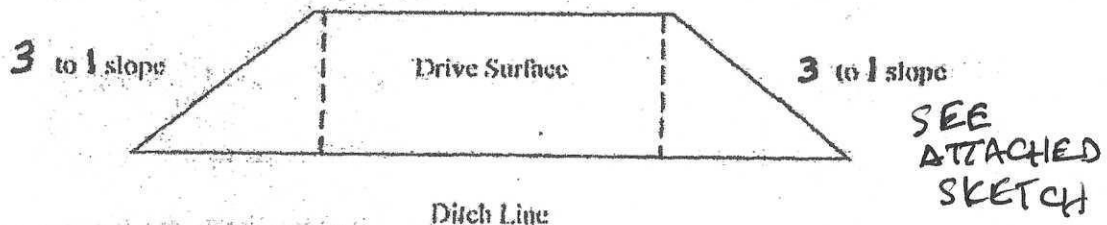
Driveway side slopes shall be of earth material, covered with black ground and seeded or of gravel. No concrete or bituminous slopes shall be constructed. Grade shall be no less than a 3 to 1 slope as per diagram below. The culvert must be a minimum of 5 feet from property line and parallel to the roadway.

The Towns' Road Superintendent will determine the size of the culvert for new and replacement culverts. Steel or Galvanized is preferred but double wall plastic is acceptable. All culverts must include metal endwalls.

All culvert/driveway installations must comply with the Manitowoc County Firefighter's Association Driveway Guidelines.

CULVERT MUST BE COMPLETED WITHIN 60 DAYS FROM THE START OF THE PROJECT.
